This is the Last Will and Testament of me Henry August Paulson at present temporarily of Calcutta but of temporary residence in the District of Rishingore in the Province of Bengal Esq. I give to my beloved wife Sarah Ellen Paulson the sum of Company Papers Three thousand absolutely I give to my son George Thurlow the sum of Company Papers one thousand and five hundred absolutely and to my nephew William Thurlow the sum of Company Papers one thousand and five hundred absolutely to be paid to them or such of them as shall attain the age of Twenty one years and in case of the death of either of them before they shall have attained that age then the bequest to him or her shall be void and the same shall form part of the residue of my Estate to be dealt with according to the trusts of this my Last Will and Testament that the said legacy to my wife be paid to her if she survives it either in one sum or in several sums (as may be most convenient for her) and either immediately after my death

or otherwise as she may think fit I give devise and bequeath all my Estate and effects real and personal whether in possession Reversion Remainder or expectancy and over which I have power to will to Frederick Alphinstone at present of Chumraudy Tracoy in the Merguige Indigo Concern in the District of Serore in the Province of Bengal Esq. and George John Thurlow of Palee Point near the Floating Light at the Sand hills in the River Hooghly in the Province of Bengal Superintendent of the Light house there and their heirs Executors administrators and assigns according to the nature thereof upon trust that they the said Frederick Alphinstone and George John Thurlow and the survivor of them and the Executors and administrators of such survivor (hereinafter named Trustees) do and shall as soon after my decease as conveniently may be Subject to the restriction hereinafter contained) convert such part or portion of my Estate and effects as shall not consist of Cash or Company's Paper into Cash and such Cash with any Cash that I may have at the time of my death after payment thereof of the aforesaid legacies to invest in Company's Paper or other the securities for the time of the Government of India and such Company's Paper together with any Company's Paper that I may have at the time of my death to hold upon Trust that they the said Trustees or the survivor of them and the Executors or administrators of such survivor do and shall pay the interest dividends and produce thereof unto my beloved Wife Sarah Ellen Paulson for and during the term of her natural life and from and immediately after her decease then upon Trust to pay apply assign and transfer all the said Capital stock and Trust securities unto and between all my Sons and Daughters in equal shares and proportions The shares of my Sons to be deemed vested in them when they shall attain the age of Twenty one years and the shares of my Daughters to be deemed vested in them or their attaining the said age or an marriage which ever may first happen but

in case any or either of my said children who being a Son shall happen to depart this life before he shall have attained the age of Twenty one years or who being a Daughter before that age or who having married before that age then I give and bequeath the part or share of him or her so dying to such of my Children as shall then surviving to be equally divided among them at such time or times his or her Original share shall become payable and my Will is that all and every the share and shares so directed to survive shall from time to time survive together with the Original share or shares until the same shall become payable and my further Will is that the interest and dividends or so much thereof as shall be thought necessary by the said Trustees or the Trustees or Trustee at the time being of this my Will shall be applied for and towards the maintenance education and advancement in the world of my said Sons and Daughters during his or their respective minorities and the residue thereof shall be invested in or upon such Securities as aforesaid and accumulate in my of Compound interest and that such accumulation shall be in trust for the said or persons who under the Trusts hereinafore declared shall become absolutely entitled to the funds whence such accumulation shall proceed and whereas upon the decease of my aunt Mrs Sarah Paulson the widow of my uncle the late Jonathan Paulson she be entitled under his Will to two several Messuages situate in Calcutta I will and desire that the Trustees of this my Will should consult the convenience entirely of my beloved wife as to sale or Concession thereof or of either of them during her life it being my Will and pleasure that she shall either live in one of the said houses herself and let the other or let both if she thinks fit and enjoy the rents and profits thereof for life or that one or both the said houses be sold for the best price that can be gotten for the same and the proceeds of sale invested in the Securities of the Government of India to follow the Trusts of this my Will

but upon the death of my wife I desire that the said houses or such of them as shall not have been converted and invested be converted invested and held upon the Trusts hereinafore declared of and concerning my Estate and effects generally I nominate and appoint my beloved wife Sarah Ellen Paulson the sole guardian of my Infant Children I appoint the said Frederick Elphinstone and George John Thurlow Executors of this my Will and upon the death of both of them the said Frederick Elphinstone and George John Thurlow or in the event of their both declining to accept and perform the Trusts of this my Will I nominate and appoint Charles Sumner Hogg Esquire the administrator General of Bengal or my person who at the time shall happen to be administrator General of Bengal Executor of this my Will I hereby revoke all Wills Testaments and Testamentary Papers by me at any time heretofore made or executed and I declare this to be my last Will and Testament which is executed by me in Duplicate this thirtieth day of January one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight.
