Notes

1. Some aircraft serial numbers may show multiple entries to reflect separate recorded events associated with the aircraft.
2. The History of the 460th Bomb Group shows aircraft no. 41-28702 as both 762nd BS letter G (Maxwell House – Good to the Last Drop) which crash landed May 10, 1944 and as 761st letter A (Pretty Baby). Pictures of both are on file. Pretty Baby pictures show the early Group designation paint scheme and the serial number on the rudder.
3. Walter Mattson indicates in his book, *Lone Wolf in Enemy Skies*, that Princess Carole was AC No. 44-41073. He indicates he had the name painted on the aircraft in September 1944 after his arrival with the aircraft. The photo used in Mattson’s book showing tail number 44-41073 has been determined to have been altered and is not reliable as identification of Princess Carole as A/C No. 44-41073. Best physical match for A/C No. 44-41073 is Ole Boomerang.
4. An aircraft with this same serial no. (44-49392) is seen as Sub-Depot Susy of the 454th BG/737th BS. Pictures as both Sub-Depot Susy and Rough Rider are on file. The American Air Museum in Britain website incorrectly shows the picture of Sub-Depot Susy as 44-42392, not 44-49392.
5. Gino Künzle (author, WWII aircraft researcher, and associated with B24bestweb.com) indicated on 12/8/2020 that 42-50582 was a PB-24J-2-FO (ex J-1-FO), which became a J-2-FO at a Modification Center. It would have been natural metal and later painted “PFF gray” or Lone Wolf color since it was a Pathfinder (equipped with H2X radar). Bohnstedt shows it as a J-1, aircraft letter X.
6. Pilot Chester Howard indicated at a Bomb Group reunion in the 1980’s in Branson, MO that he recalled that the name of the aircraft he was flying that day was named “My Arkansas Sweetheart” not “Jane” as indicated in MACR 9875. This info comes from Cary Newman, son of Howard crew member Glen F. Newman.
7. 44-48769, May Bell, had a nose wheel collapse on landing 3/4/1945. Also reportedly served with the 15th AAF/450th BG/721st BS. Photo with 460th Airmen on file.

- 42-51176 is shown on the aircraft inventory list in Bohnstedt's 460th Bomb Group History. A picture of this aircraft with clearly seen serial number is shown on B24bestweb's site with tail markings of the 98th BG/343rd BS and named "Reluctant Virgin".
- Bohnstedt shows 42-52385, Straight Shot, as 760th BS letter H and then transferred to the 763rd BS as letter G. He notes Lt. Ben Haller as Pilot. Haller was with the 761st BS. On file is a crew photo belonging to Edward C. Brooks, a bombardier with the 460th BG 761st BS identifying the individuals in the photo as the Straight Shot B-24 crew with the 761st BS.
- The last olive drab bombers produced at Ford's Willow Run facility (FO) were the B-24H-20 series. B-24-H25 and subsequent Ford bombers were natural metal finish. Bombers equipped as Pathfinder (PFFs) were typically painted Pathfinder Gray after arrival in Italy.
- Bohnstedt's 460th Bomb Group History book indicates the 460th Bomb Group was assigned 62 B-24Hs that were original group aircraft that made the initial move to Spinazzola, Italy. Each aircraft carried 14 personnel comprised of 10 crew and 4 passengers. An additional 1,425 personnel traveled to the 460th BG base by ship. Currently, this inventory list does not identify all 62 original aircraft.
- 42-78410 crashed on 4/27/1945 on an unofficial mission to supply troops cut-off by enemy. Three crew members were KIA – Harold J. Snyder (Pilot), Morton A. Rosenbloom, and Lionel J. Emswiler. All were 763rd BS members. Another source, Henrick B. Hansen, 761st BS, indicates he wrote a poem included in the 460th Bomb Group History (page 30) while on the 8/12/1944 mission at the Southern Belle's radio operator's table.
- 42-95295 was previously carried on this inventory list as named "Pappy's Pride". That is currently believed to be an error and that Pappy's Pride was a 464th BG aircraft. It is possible that the 460th BG's 42-95295 was actually named "Silver Satan" although there is no conclusive evidence to date.
