Obituary - Mrs. Flora MacVicar

Many relatives and friends were saddened to learn of the death of Mrs. Flora MacVicar wife of Angus MacVicar of Mascarene, which occurred at the saint John General Hospital on Wednesday June 20.

Mrs. MacVicar was the daughter of the late John and Margaret (Hoyt) Stewart born May 10, 1895, at Mascarene where she had lived the most of her lifetime. She was a member of the United Baptist Church of Mascarene.

Besides her husband, Mrs. MacVicar is survived by three sisters, Mrs. William Matthews (Bertha) of L'Etete; Mrs. Bert Armstrong (Grace) of St. George and Mrs. Cecil MacMahon (Josephine) of Walnut, California; several nephews and nieces. Three brothers and a sister died a number of years ago.

The largely attended funeral was held from the St. George Funeral Home, where service was conducted by Rev. C.A. Hicks, pastor of the United Baptist church, assisting him was Rev. dr. John Y.
