Descendants of Horatio Clark and Betsy Bixby

HORATIO CLARK was born 15 Feb 1800, in Gorham, Me., the son of Moses Clark and Martha Rogers. Horatio was a blacksmith and lived in Westford, Mass. He married, 14 Sep 1819, **ELIZABETH ("BETSEY") BIXBY**, in Westford. She was born 22 Feb 1798, in Westford, and was the daughter of Asa Bixby Jr. and Lucy Gilson. Horatio died 14 May 1833, in Westford.

According to the Clark genealogy, Betsey married Henry Proctor, of Lowell, Mass., on 9 Apr 1835. He died 27 Feb 1841. If this is true, it seems odd that in later records she is known as Betsey Clark, and not Betsey Proctor.

In 1850, she lived in Nashua, N.H., with two of her daughters and their husbands:

Dana Woodward, 39, painter, b. N.H.

Martha Woodward, 30, b. Mass.

Edward D. Woodward, 2

Albin Clifford, 26, carpenter, b. N.H.

Mariah Clifford, 27, b. Mass.

Four apparently unrelated persons, John Cilley, 19; Joseph Heald, 23; Charles Lawrence, 23, and Merrill Wither, 21, are also listed with the family.

According to the Clark genealogy, she lived in Woburn in 1866. She has not been found on the 1860, or 1870 census.

She died 15 Jun 1878, in Waltham, in a railroad accident. She was struck by a train while attempting to cross the track, and killed instantly.

An Old Lady Killed By Express Train

The 8:30 express from Boston this morning struck an unknown woman, who attempted to cross the track near the upper engine house, and killed her instantly. She was about seventy years of age, and was plainly but neatly attired in black. Her body was fearfully mangled. She had in her hand a small canvas bag, in which there was written "Betsey Clark," "Marin Knapp." The wife of Mr. John Clark, living on Chestnut Street, viewed the body at the freight house and recognized it as that of Mrs. Betsey Clark of Weston, the mother of her husband, who is at present in California. Medical Examiner Hosmer viewed the body, but will not hold an inquest. No blame is to be laid to the employees of the railroad corporation, as the old lady stepped directly before the locomotive. She had just come from the house of her daughter-in-law, and was on her way to the depot to take the train for Boston. The body was not as badly mutilated

as first reported. Her arms and legs were broken, a foot crushed, and there was a deep cut on her face beneath the mouth. The body has been taken to the residence of Mr. Clark.

She is probably buried in Mt. Feake cemetery, where, in John R. Clark's plot, there is a small headstone marked "mother."

(2) **EDWARD CLARK** (HORATIO CLARK) was born 1 Feb 1820 in Waltham, MA. He married **CATHERINE HARRIS WHITNEY** 27 Oct 1843 in Weston, MA. Catherine was born in about 1823 in Watertown, MA.

According to the Descendants of Hugh Clark, Edward moved to Springfield, MA, where he was an armorer. He died 30 Nov 1849 in Springfield, MA: "he was found dead in a field near his house. A coroner's jury decided he had fallen dead in a fit, but from some marks of violence, and other circumstances, it seemed probably that he was murdered."¹

Catherine married, second, on 15 May 1853, in Marlborough, **MOSES WARD WOODWARD**. He was baptized 14 Apr 1811 in Marlborough, and was the adopted son of Moses Woodward. He had married, first, Fanny B. Wells.

Moses Woodward, 48, painter, and Catherine Woodward, 37, are listed on the 1860 census, in Marlborough, with along with Ellen Clark, 18, John Clark, 16, Clara Clark, 12, Henry Woodward, 4, and George W. Woodward, 2. Moses and Catherine are listed in 1870 in Marlborough, with Henry Woodward, 14, George Woodward 11, and Sarah Woodward, 7. Catherine died after 1870. Moses apparently died in about 1872, when his estate was administered.

(3) **MARTHA CLARK** (HORATIO CLARK) was born 19 Dec 1820 in Westford, Middlesex, MA. She died 6 Jun 1869 in Charlestown, MA. Martha married, first, **DANA WOODWARD** 28 Jul 1839, in Lowell, MA.³ Dana was born in about 1811 in Sutton, NH.⁴ He was a painter. By 1850 he and Martha were living with Martha's mother Betsey (Bixby) Clark, in Nashua, NH. His death date is not known.⁵

She married, second, **THOMAS RUSSELL CUSHING**, 5 Oct 1857, in Waltham, MA.⁶ He was born in 1811 in Cambridge, MA, the son of Martin and Sally (-----) Cushing. He had married,

second, Martha's sister, Lydia Maria Clark. He died 5 Jan 1865, in West Cambridge, MA.⁷ His occupation was mason.⁸ (Thomas married, first, Sarah Ann Smith, intention 19 Aug 1837, Waltham.⁹ He is listed on the 1850 census in West Cambridge, MA, with Sarah and two children, Sarah J., 10, and Thomas R. Cushing Jr., 7.)

(4) **LYDIA MARIA CLARK** (HORATIO CLARK) was born 8 Jun 1822 in Westford, MA. She died 21 Jan 1856 in Waltham, MA.

She married **ALBIN REUBEN CLIFFORD** 27 Oct 1842 in Waltham, MA. This marriage apparently ended in divorce.¹⁰ She married, second, **THOMAS RUSSELL CUSHING** 24 Jan 1854 in West Cambridge, MA. Thomas was born in 1811 in Cambridge, MA. He died on 5 Jan 1865 in West Cambridge, MA.

(5) **JOHN RICHARDSON CLARK** (HORATIO CLARK) was born 11 Jun 1824 in Westford, MA. He died 3 Dec 1905 in Waltham, MA. He was buried in Mt. Feake Cemetery, Waltham, MA. He married **CAROLINE MARIA DERBY**, 15 Sep 1846, in Weston, MA. She was born 6 Feb 1828 in Weston, the daughter of Capt. John Derby and Martha Fiske. She died 5 Jan 1915, in Pomona, CA. She is also buried in Mt. Feake Cemetery, Waltham.

John R. Clark was a machinist. In 1851 he went to California via the Isthmus of Panama, staying until 1854. The family moved to Waltham in 1865. He worked for the Waltham Watch Factory there.

(6) **ELLEN M. CLARK** (EDWARD CLARK, HORATIO CLARK) was born 3 Feb 1843 in Weston, MA. She married **THOMAS LIVERMORE** 1 May 1869 in Marlborough, MA. He was born 6 Nov 1835, in Fitchburg, MA, and was the son of Thomas Livermore and Sylvia Hale. He was a Civil War veteran. According to his bio on findagrave.com: "Thomas enlisted in Company I, Massachusetts 1st Infantry Regiment on 24 May 1861 and mustered out on 25 May 1864 at Boston, MA. Second, he enlisted in Company H, Massachusetts 4th Heavy Artillery Regiment on 20 Aug 1864 and mustered out on 17 Jun 1865 at Washington, DC."

In 1870 they lived in Marlborough, where he worked in a shoe shop.¹¹ He is not found on the 1880 census. Ellen died 15 Mar 1878 in Marlborough, of consumption.¹² She is buried in the Spring Hill Cemetery, in Marlborough.¹³ In 1900, Thomas lived in Chelsea, Me., in a home for disabled veterans. He died 27 Jul 1919 in Fitchburg, and is buried in the Forest Hill Cemetery there.¹⁴

(10) **LYDIA MARIA WOODWARD** (MARTHA CLARK, HORATIO CLARK) was born 19 Nov 1846 in Lowell, MA.¹⁶ She married **JAMES CLARK KNAPP** 9 Apr 1865 in Charlestown, MA. He was born in May 1841,¹⁷ in Lawrence, NY, the son of George F. and Electa Knapp.¹⁸ Lydia died 7 Apr 1889 in Boston, MA.¹⁹

In 1900, James lived with his cousin William Knapp, in Boston. He lived in Boston in 1920 with his grandson, Edward C. Mason. At 78, his occupation was given as tin peddler.²⁰ He

continued to live in Boston in April 1930, with his unmarried grandson Edward, then 29 years old.²¹ He died 6 May 1930 in Charlestown.²² According to an obituary, he was “for 20 years treasurer of the Charlestown Veteran Fireman’s Association, and one of the first members of the association...He was a veteran of the Civil War and as a member of the Charlestown Fire Department worked at the big Boston fire in 1872... He was also in the tinware business for 60 years and was one of the oldest in the tinware business in New England.”²³

(11) **EDWARD DANA WOODWARD** (MARTHA CLARK, HORATIO CLARK) was born in May 1849 in Lowell, MA.²⁴ He died, probably, in 1925. He married, first, **ELLEN (“NELLIE”) STEWART**, 19 May 1869 in Charlestown, MA. At that time, his occupation was carpenter. Nellie was the daughter of Thomas Stewart and Kate Jones.²⁵

In 1870 he lived with wife Ellen in Charlestown, MA. He was likely the Edward D. Woodward, huckster, 30 years old, widower, who is listed on the 1880 census in Malden, MA, the adopted son of William N. Marsh.²⁶

He married, second, **EDNA IDELLA STANHOPE**, 4 May 1891 in Malden, MA. She was born in Jan 1869, in Vermont,²⁷ and was the daughter of Dorman and Harriet Stanhope. She died 15 Sep 1908, in St. Albans, VT.²⁸ According to a death notice in the Burlington Weekly Free Press, she had been suffering from a tumor and underwent an operation the day before she died.

In 1900 Edward and Edna lived in Somerville, MA, where he is listed as a salesman. In 1910 he was lodging in Boston, and was a traveling salesman. Edward is *probably* the Edward D. Woodward who died in 1925 at age 76, and is buried in the Hillside East Cemetery, Shrewsbury, MA.²⁹

(12) **LUCY MARIA CUSHING** (Lydia Maria Clark, Horatio Clark) was born on 29 Nov 1855 in Nashua, NH. She died 6 Dec 1902 in Somerville, MA.

She married **JOHN TENNEY McLOUD** 24 Nov 1875 in Charlestown, MA. John was born 1 Oct 1852 in Charlestown, MA. He was the son of John and Eunice (Strafford) McCloud. On the 1900 census he lived in Somerville, MA, and his occupation is listed as sorting clerk in a post office.³¹ He died 17 Mar 1908 in Somerville, MA, of pneumonia. He was buried in Mt. Pleasant Cemetery, Arlington, MA.³²

Charles married **MARY L. STEARNS**, 21 Jul 1874, in Manchester, NH. She was born in about 1856, and died 14 Feb 1916. She was the daughter of Ambrose Stearns and Cynthia Louisa Viles.

Charles was a machinist with the Waltham Watch Factory.

(15) **ALICE MAUD CLARK** (JOHN RICHARDSON CLARK, HORATIO CLARK) was born 4 Sep 1863 in Weston, MA. She died 5 Sep 1948 in Claremont, CA. She was buried in Oak Park Cemetery, in Claremont, CA.

She married **HARRY STILLMAN PRATT**, 5 May 1892, in Pomona, CA. He was born 22 Aug 1867 in Cambridge, MA, the son of Francis Lowell Pratt and Mary Ann Brown. He was an orange grower and piano tuner/salesman.

The marriage ended in divorce. Harry died 28 Dec 1944, in Pomona, CA.

(16) **EDWARD JOHN LIVERMORE** (ELLEN M. CLARK, EDWARD CLARK, HORATIO CLARK) was born 29 Jun 1870 in Marlborough, MA.³³ He married **ELLEN MACDONALD** 25 Sep 1902 in Bartlett, NH. He died 7 Jul 1929 in Rochester, NH.³⁴ Ellen was born 24 Nov 1871 in North Sydney, Nova Scotia, Canada. She died in Nov 1959, and is buried in Lovell Lake Cemetery, Sanbornville, NH.³⁵

In 1900, Edward was a railroad brakeman and lived in Wakefield, NH. His death was caused by a fracture of cervical vertebrae due to “falling from freight car while working.”

(19) **LILLA BERTHA KNAPP** (LYDIA MARIA WOODWARD, MARTHA CLARK, HORATIO CLARK) was born 27 Aug 1867 in Charlestown, MA.³⁶ She married **ALBERT FRANKLIN MASON** 26 Aug 1891 in Boston, MA. Albert was born on 6 Dec 1864 in Marlborough, NH, the son of George Franklin Mason and Eunice Almira Parker.³⁷ In 1900, Albert and family are listed on the census in Somerville, MA, where he was a fireman.³⁸ He is listed on a 1902 city directory as a fireman living at 21 Maple Ave. in Somerville.³⁹ On the 1910 census, Lilla was living with her father James C. Knapp, and sons Clarence and Edwin. She is listed as having been the mother of 3 children, 2 living. Lilla died 22 Oct 1919, at the Massachusetts Homeopathic Hospital in Boston.⁴⁰

HELEN FRANCES MCGINCHY, 17 Aug 1919; he was an advertising clerk for the *Boston Transcript* in 1917;⁴² in 1930 he lived in Lexington, MA. At the time of his death he was the operator of a printing shop on Atlantic Ave., Boston. He was a World War I veteran.⁴³

Child: (1) *Hugh Clark Mason*, b. 7 Mar 1925, Boston, MA; d. 31 Dec 1994, Ventura, CA; m. Louise Ann Erickson. He was a geologist, "whose geological knowledge of and experiences in South and Central America were legendary." He received his B.S. degree in geology from Harvard Univ., and a master's degree from Stanford Univ.⁴⁴

(21) **WILLARD JOHN MCLOUD** (LUCY MARIA CUSHING, LYDIA MARIA CLARK, HORATIO CLARK) was born 18 Jan 1877 in Boston, MA. He died 5 May 1943,⁴⁶ in Boston, MA. He married **LUCY MAY HOBBS** 9 Oct 1899 in Somerville, MA. Lucy was born 25 Jul 1876 in Boston, MA. She was the daughter of Joseph Walker Hobbs and Ada Alice Brown. She died 14 Dec 1965.

Willard was a salesman. According to his obituary in the *Boston Traveler*, "Prior to becoming associated 10 years ago with the LaTouraine Coffee Company, Mr. McCloud had been employed for 36 years with the Chase & Sanborn Company." He was "prominent in Masonic orders." He had lived in West Medford, MA, at the time of his death, and earlier in Somerville.

23. **LOWELL CLARK PRATT** (ALICE MAUD CLARK, JOHN RICHARDSON CLARK, HORATIO CLARK) was born 31 Dec 1894 in Pomona, CA. He died 6 Jun 1979 in Wheaton, MD. He was buried in Oak Park Cemetery, Claremont, CA.

Lowell married **DOROTHY LOUISE NEELY**, daughter of Charles Gracchus Neely and Lucia Hull Fish, 21 May 1918 in Claremont, CA. Dorothy was born on 28 Feb 1895 in Evanston, IL. She died 22 May 1974 in Silver Spring, MD. She was buried in Oak Park Cemetery, Claremont, CA.

Dorothy graduated from Pomona College. Lowell Clark Pratt graduated from Columbia University School of Journalism. He was a newspaper reporter, editor, and part-owner of the Selma, Calif, *Enterprise*. Later he taught Journalism at San Jose State University.
