and Testament of me Robert Comely of Wotton parish in the County of Gloucester Gentleman made the nineteenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six as follows that is to say first I give and bequeath to my direct and only daughter wife of Mr Thomas Simcock the sum of five hundred and fifty pounds in ready money is lying at my house and if she is not then living I give and bequeath the said five hundred and fifty pounds to the said Thomas Simcock in trust to be by him paid to and divided amongst such of the Children of my said direct as shall live to attain the age of twenty one year or more and as they shall respectively attain that age in equal shares together with the interest thereof which I trust shall from time to time be repaid out at interest for the purpose of accumulation Also I give and bequeath to Mr William Clipp Osborne

The sum of Twenty pounds and to Thomas  
 Benjamin Joseph George Eleanor and Doctor Signala  
 and Mary King the four Brothers and three Sisters of my  
 late wife the sum of five Guineas a piece and I also  
 give and bequeath to my servant Nathaniel Tyler the  
 sum of Ten pounds and so hereby will order and direct  
 the aforesaid Legacies to be paid within six months next  
 after my decease all the rest Residue and Remainders  
 of my Goods Chattels Monies Rights and Credits after  
 payment of my Debts funeral Expences Charges of a  
 proving this my will and the beforementioned Legacies  
 I give and bequeath to my Brother John Comely if  
 living at my decease and if he is not then living  
 I give and bequeath the same Residue and the  
 Remainder of my Goods Chattels Monies Rights and Credits  
 to the said William Slipp Osborne in Trust to be by  
 him together with the interest thereof paid and  
 divided in equal shares to and amongst some of the  
 children of my said Brother John Comely as shall live  
 to attain the Age of twenty one Years when and as  
 they shall respectively attain that Age and the principal  
 in the meantime to be placed out at interest on  
 such security as the said William Slipp Osborne shall  
 approve of and the interest to be also placed out in  
 like manner from time to time as the same shall  
 become due and be received for the purpose of an  
 accumulation until the several and respective times  
 for paying and dividing the several parts thereof and  
 of the principal Monies as aforesaid and I do hereby  
 further will order and direct that the said William  
 Slipp Osborne his Executors and assigns shall and may  
 reimburse themselves out of the said Trust Monies and  
 for his and their loss of time and for all Costs and  
 Charges Expences and Damages which he or they or  
 shall or may pay bear sustain be at or be put unto  
 for or by reason or means or on account of the  
 Execution or Management of the aforesaid Trust and  
 that he or they shall not be answerable or accountable  
 for any more Money than shall actually come to  
 his or their hands nor for the loss of any Money  
 by depositing for safe custody or any insufficient or  
 security or otherwise without a wilful neglect or default
