



heirs and assigns shall have full power and authority at any time after my decease to advance the whole of the said sum of one thousand pounds or any part thereof to my said son Joseph County for the purpose of the advancement in life if they shall deem it prudent and expedient so to do or to withhold the same in trust as they shall see good and if the said sum of one thousand pounds or any part thereof shall remain in the hands of my said trustees William County and Richard Carter their heirs and assigns at the time of the decease of my said son Joseph County then I will and direct that the same shall be divided in equal portions to and amongst such child or children of my said son Joseph County lawfully issuing as shall respectively live and attain the age of twenty one years and in default of such issue of my said son Joseph County then I give and devise the same in equal portions to and amongst such child or children of my sons John County All son County Edward County and my daughter Elizabeth Withham lawfully issuing as shall respectively live and attain the age of twenty one years and whereas I have already and before the execution of this my will given to my son John County the sum of two thousand pounds for the purpose of his advancement in life and have moreover lent to him the sum of one thousand pounds now I hereby will and direct that the said sum of one thousand pounds now due and owing from him to me shall be held and taken as part of my personal estate and applicable to the purpose of this my will if the same shall remain outstanding and due from him to me at the time of my decease also I give and devise to my said trustees William County and Richard Carter their heirs and assigns the sum of eight hundred pounds of lawful Money of Great Britain to be taken out of my personal estate in trust that they do as soon as may be after my decease cause the said sum of eight hundred pounds to be invested in their names in the public funds or such other legal securities as they shall deem sufficient to pay or cause to be paid to my son Edward County or his assigns the interest thereof as the same shall accrue and be received by them or my said trustees their heirs or assigns

of them shall respectively sustain expaid or be
 put into for or by reason of the several Trusts =
 lawfully in them disposed and as to all the =
 right residue and remainder of my real and
 personal Estate and Effects whatsoever =
 whatsoever not herebefore disposed of I =
 give devise and bequeath the same and every =
 part thereof (subject to the payment of my just
 debts and funeral Expences unto my said son
 William Comely to hold to him his heirs =
 Executors Administrators and assigns for ever
 and I do hereby constitute and appoint my
 said son William Comely Sole Executor of this
 my will hereby revoking and making null and =
 void all former wills by me at any time =
 heretofore made and made this only to be my
 will contained in five sheets of paper affixed
 together at my hand and to the fifth and =
 last sheet my hand and seal this second
 day of December one thousand eight hundred =
 and two John Comely  signed sealed = = =
 published and declared by the Testator as and
 for his last will and Testament in the presence of
 us who in his presence and at his request and
 in the presence of each other have subscribed = =
