John Garrett Of Garland Is Dead at 78

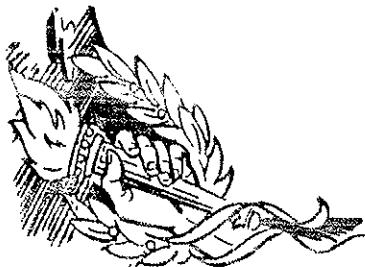
GARLAND — John W. Garrett, 78, of Garland, died yesterday at his home after an illness of six years.

Mr. Garrett served one term on the Garland City Council and was a charter member of the Garland Lions Club. He worked as a meatcutter and had operated a meat and grocery store before retiring.
