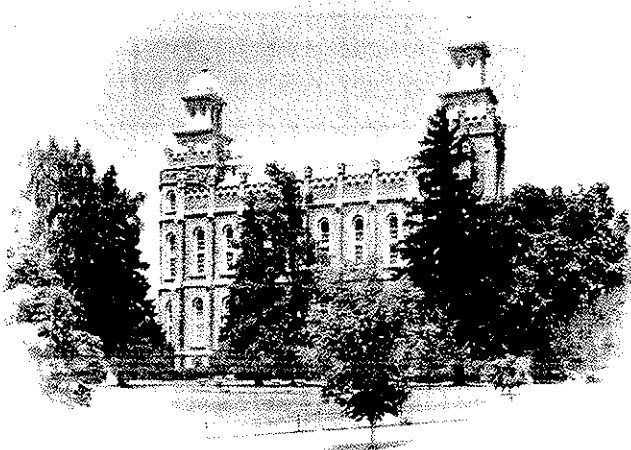


He was an active member of the
