quarter of Section Seven in Township thirty four North of Range two East
North Township containing Eighty Acres, to be the same here on ags.
Together with all the privileges and appurtenances, to the said land in any
way appertaining and belonging, to have and to hold the above granted premises
to the said Adam Snyder his heirs and assigns, to his and their use and
of forever. And he the said Milo Hard for himself, his heirs executors
and administrators does covenant with the said Adam Snyder his heirs and assigns
that he is lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that they are free
from all incumbrances; that he has good right to sell and convey the same to the said
Adam Snyder as aforesaid; And that he will and his heirs executors and ad-
ministrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Adam Snyder
his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful demands of all persons.

over to the said Adam Snyder his heirs and assigns all her right and title of
power in the aforesigned premises.
