It would appear that Martin Delaney, the head of the household in the 1860 census, was dead by 1870. By the time that this census was taken, Mary Delaney, wife of Martin Delaney prior to his death, has remarried. The census data indicates that Mary and William Shelly were married in March of 1870. The children of Martin and Mary Delaney are living in the Shelly household: Catherine, John [John Francis], James [James Henry], Mary [Mary Frances] and Martin. Thomas Delaney, relationship unknown, is also residing in the Shelly household.
