Mary, formerly Mary Delaney, is listed as the wife of William Shelly in this census. The children of Mary and Martin Delaney are most likely incorrectly enumerated under the Shelly surname. Documentation from periods after the 1880 census indicates that the children continued to use the Delaney surname after the marriage of Mary and William. Catherine Delaney had left the household by the time this census was taken. Martin is incorrectly listed as "Morton."
