NOTICE To Joseph (Giuseppe) Pesoli: You are hereby notified that a complaint has been filed on behalf of the United States of America to No. 4659 Civil in the United States District Court for the Middle District of Pennsylvania, demanding that the Order admitting you, the said defendant, Joseph (Giuseppe) Pesoli to citizenship, be revoked and set aside and that the Certificate of Naturalization issued to you be canceled as having been obtained through fraud in that you, the said defendant, did not, within five (5) years after your naturalization, return to the country of your nativity and took permanent residence therein, and you are required to appear or answer the said Complaint on or before the 22nd day of October, 1951 and, in default thereof, the Court may enter an Order revoking and setting aside the Order admitting you to citizenship and canceling the Certificate of Naturalization.
