

Beginning at Sturts from White Oak thence off new Line North
 Sixty six Degrees East one hundred and four poles to a Locust and
 North ten Degrees West two poles to a Branch one hundred to a Branch
 and one hundred and eighteen to a White oak North five degrees
 East ninety Eight poles to a Box oak West one hundred Twenty
 two poles to a white oak South thirty Seven West one hundred
 and Eighty two poles to a white oak South fifty East one hundred
 and Twenty four poles to frontiers in Sturts Line on the North forty
 six East six poles to his former hickory North twenty three East sixty
 two poles to a Hickory and South Eighty six East Ninety Eight poles
 to a White oak north forty on a diagonal Ninety Poles to the
 Beginning being the same coming by deed of the fourth day of
 September one thousand seven hundred and Eighty six from
 Dan Stuart to the said Edmund Winston which deed was taken
 for the Benefit of William Mead by him sold to J^r Dittin
 In consequence whereof this Indenture is now made to have and to
 hold the said Land and Remains with all the appertinances the
 same Belonging or in any wise appertaining to him the said Edmund
 Winston doth by these presents Warrant and forever Defend the said
 Grants here from him the said Edmund Winston his heirs and
 assigns unto the said J^r Dittin and his heirs forever In witness
 whereof the said Edmund Winston hath hereunto set his hand &

This Indenture made this twenty seventh day of
 December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred seven hundred
 and ninety two by & between Thomas Williams of the one part Joshua
 Brock of the other part both of Franklin County Wth Virginia that the said
 Thomas Williams for and in consideration of the sum of thirty Pounds in hand
 paid by the said Joshua Brock to the said Thomas Williams he
 doth Bargain sell and Deliver unto the said Joshua Brock one
 certain Tract or parcels of Land containing one hundred and Eighty
 Eight acres of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of
 Franklin Near the maple Branch a Branch of Snow Creek and bounded
 as followeth (to wit) Beginning at post oak in Branch thence north
 five North forty six Degrees west one hundred and Twenty poles to a
 post oak South one degree East Twenty six poles to a Chestnut Corner
 Red Oak on said Branch thence with that that line South thirty
 two degrees west one hundred and forty six poles crossing the line to a
 Black oak thence in said Branch Line thence with that line South ten
 Ten degrees East two hundred and Eighteen poles crossing three Branches
 to said Brocks line thence with it North thirty six Degrees East Two
 Hundred & Eighty six poles crossing a Race to the stable Branch to
 the Beginning and also Forty acres Land being more or less joining the
 aforesaid Tract on the South side of stable Branch it being part of
 the once purchase Purchase Copelanda by them to have and to hold
 with its appertinances thenceunto Belonging of the said Tracts or parcels
 of Land.
