

## Descendants of George Colville Smith

*This document supersedes the document of the same title published on January 10, 2011. The parents and ancestry of Mary Elizabeth Brower, wife of George Colville Smith, have now been identified. ### Generation One

1. **GEORGE COLVILLE' SMITH** was born circa 1843 New York City, New York Co., New York.<sup>1</sup> He married **Mary Elizabeth Brower**, daughter of **Robert D. Brower** and **Mary Robinson**, New York City, New York, on 7 Aug 1861.<sup>2</sup> He died on 20 May 1897 Hackensack, Bergen Co., New Jersey.<sup>3</sup>

Also known as **Colville Smith**.<sup>4</sup> He appeared on the census in 1855 Ward 16, New York City, New York Co., New York, as Colville Smith, age 12, born in New York Co.<sup>5</sup> Colville Smith served during the Civil War. He enlisted 25 May 1862 in Company H, 7th Regt. New York, as a musician. He was mustered out on 5 Sep 1862 at New York.<sup>6,7</sup> He appeared on the census on 24 Jun 1870 Ward 16, New York City, New York Co., New York, Colwell Smith, age 27, born in New York. Clerk for steamer. In the household are Lizzie Smith (age 31), Robert Smith (8), Lizzie Smith (6), Isaac Smith (4), Morris Brower (26), Catharine Brower (27), James Wiley (25), Elizabteh Wiley (20), Charles Wiley (16).<sup>8</sup> He

appeared on the census on 15 Jun 1880 Jersey City, Hudson Co., New Jersey, Colville Smith, age 37, born in New York. Both parents born in New York. Policeman. In the household are his wife Mary E., son Robert B., daughter Mary E., son Isaac, son George C., brother Archibald A. Smith, age 32, boarder Fred Seggrem, age 20, and servant Maria Finnerty, age 18.<sup>9</sup> In 1891 **George Colville Smith** resided Jersey City, Hudson Co., New Jersey; as Colville Smith, at 8 Court House Place.<sup>10</sup> In 1892 **George Colville Smith** resided Jersey City, Hudson Co., New Jersey; at 148 Palisade Ave. Colville Smith, detective.<sup>11</sup> In 1893 **George Colville Smith** resided Jersey City, Hudson Co., New Jersey; at 76 Fairview Ave. Colville Smith, detective.<sup>12</sup> He appeared on the census in 1895 Ward 9, Jersey City, Hudson Co., New Jersey, Colville Smith (male, age 20-60). In the household are Archibald A. Smith (m, 20-60), Isaac A. Smith (m, 20-60), George C. Smith (m, 20-60), Robert Brower (m, 20-60), Mary E. Smith (f, 10-60), Evelyn Smith (f, 10-60), Kate Smith (f, 10-60), Kate Kierman (f, 5-10), Robert B. Smith (m, 20-60).<sup>13</sup>

**MARY ELIZABETH BROWER** was born circa 1838 Monmouth Co., New Jersey.<sup>14</sup> She died on 6 Jun 1914 Jamaica, Queens Co., New York.<sup>15</sup> Also known as **Lizzie**.<sup>16</sup> Also known as **Mary Brower**.<sup>17</sup> Also known as **Mary Elizabeth Brewer**.<sup>18</sup> She appeared on the census on 20 Jul 1850 Brick, Ocean Co., New Jersey, Mary Brower, age 13, born in New Jersey.<sup>19</sup> She appeared on the census on 24 Jun 1870 Ward 16, New York City, New York Co., New York, as Lizzie Smith, age 31, born in New Jersey. Keeps house.<sup>20</sup> She appeared on the census on 15 Jun 1880 Jersey City, Hudson Co., New Jersey, as Mary E. Smith, age 36, born in New Jersey. Both parents born in New Jersey. Housekeeper.<sup>21</sup> She appeared on the census on 6 Jun 1900 Ward 9, Jersey City, Hudson Co., New Jersey, as Mary E. Smith, head of household, age 55, born May 1845 in Virginia (certainly incorrect). Father born in North Carolina, mother born in New York. Widow. She has had 4 children, all are living in 1900. In the household are her son George C. Smith, brother-in-law Archibald A. Smith, servant Raddie Polinski and boarders Sherwood Hanna and Francis Hanna (husband & wife).<sup>22</sup>

He appeared on the census on 24 Jun 1870 Ward 16, New York City, New York Co., New York, Robert Smith, age 8, born in New York.<sup>26</sup> He appeared on the census on 15 Jun 1880 Jersey City, Hudson Co., New Jersey, Robert B. Smith, age 18, born in New Jersey. Single. A broker.<sup>27</sup> He appeared on the census on 8 Jun 1900 Ward 4, Hackensack, Bergen Co., New Jersey, Robert Smith, age 38, born May 1862 in New Jersey. Both parents born in New Jersey. A bond broker. Married for 5 years. He is enumerated as son-in-law in the household of Isaac I. Cole.<sup>28</sup>

**HILAH BALMER COLE** was born in May 1862 New Jersey.<sup>29</sup> Also known as **Hilah Boliver Cole**.<sup>30</sup> She appeared on the census on 8 Jun 1900 Ward 4, Hackensack, Bergen Co., New Jersey, Hilah B. Smith, age 38, born May 1862 in New Jersey. Married for five years. No children. She and her husband, Robert Smith, live in her parent's household.<sup>31</sup>

- + 3 ii. Lillie Mae SMITH was born on 21 Jan 1864 New York. She married **Milton Welch** Jersey City, Hudson Co., New Jersey, on 2 Jun 1886. She died on 24 Aug 1947 Englewood, Bergen Co., New Jersey.
- + 4 iii. Isaac A. SMITH was born in Sep 1865 in either New Jersey (1880 census) or New York (1900 census). He married **Evelyn Fleming** Manhattan, New York Co., New York, on 27 Dec 1888.

**MILTON WELCH** was born in Jul 1865 New York.<sup>41</sup> He appeared on the census on 6 Jun 1900 Ward 3, Hackensack, Bergen Co., New Jersey, Milton Welch, age 34, born July 1865 in New York. Both parents born in New York. Married for 13 years. A bookkeeper. In the household are his wife Lillie M., children Madeline, Edgar and Mary, and mother Emily J. Welch, age 64. Also Bessie Carlson, servant, age 18.<sup>42</sup>

**EVELYN FLEMING** was born in Feb 1868 New York.<sup>59</sup> She appeared on the census on 8 Jun 1900 Ward 9, Jersey City, Hudson Co., New Jersey, as Evelyn Smith, age 32, born Feb 1868 in New York. Father born in Vermont, mother in Massachusetts. Married for 11 years. She has had 5 children, 3 are living in 1900.<sup>60</sup> She appeared on the census on 17 May 1910 Millstone, Monmouth Co., New Jersey, Evelyn Smith, head of household, age 43, born in New York. Father born in Vermont, mother born in Massachusetts. Married for 21 years. Has had 7 children, 5 are living in 1910. In the household are sons Robert B., Colville, Archibald A., and George A., and daughter Harlah (all surnamed Smith). Occupation: farming.<sup>61</sup>
