

Descendants of Paulus Dirckszen

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Generation One

1. PAULUS' DIRCKSZEN was possibly born between 1620 and 1625. He married first before 1647 **Geertje Williamse**.¹ He married second before 1652 **Jannetje Jans** (assuming Jannetje is the mother of Elizabeth and Geertruyd).² He died between 29 Mar 1688 and 24 May 1692; (dates of will and proving).

Immigrant ancestor to America in 1651.³ He was admitted to the Brooklyn, Kings Co., Long Island, New York, on 25 Dec 1662 with an attestation from Fort Orange (now Albany, New York).⁴ On 27 Feb 1664 Paulus Dirckszen was among those nominated from Wallabout, for election to the positions of Elder and Deacon for the Brooklyn Reformed Dutch Church.⁵ On 9 Apr 1664 Paulus Dirckszen and Geertje Gijsberts witnessed the confirmation of Janneken Jans, from Almelo, at the Brooklyn Reformed Dutch Church.⁶ He appeared on the assessment list of Breuckelen, Kings Co., Long Island, New York, in 1676 Paulus Dierckse, 2 polls 2 horses 2 oxen 5 cows 2 do of 3 yrs 5 do of 2 yrs 3 do of 1 yr. 5 hogs for £127, 12 morgens land & valley for £24.

⁷ He witnessed the baptism of **Paulus Van der Voort**, son of **Paulus Michielszen Van der Voort** and **Elisabeth Poulussen**, on 8 Jul 1681 Midwoud, Kings Co., Long Island, New York, (sponsors Paulus Dircksz, Annetje Teunis, Hieronijmus Rapailie).⁸ He appeared on the assessment list of Breuckelen, Kings Co., Long Island, New York, on 26 Sep 1683 Poulus Dirckse, 1 poll 3 horses 5 cows 2 do of 3 yrs 4 do of 2 yrs 2 do of 1 yr 1 do of 6 yr 25 morgens land, total £156.⁹ He witnessed the baptism of **Richard Hoff**, son of **Dirck Poulussen** and **Sara Yates**, on 29 Aug 1686 Old First Dutch Reformed Church of Brooklyn, Brooklyn, Kings Co., Long Island, New York, (witnesses: Poulus Dickson, Elisabeth Poulussen).¹⁰ He took the Oath of Allegiance in 1687 Breuckelen, Kings Co., Long Island, New York, "Paulus dirckse, 36 Jeare."¹¹ His will was dated on 29 Mar 1688 proved 24 May 1692. Joint will of Paulus Dirckse and his wife Jannetje Jans, at Bedfors of Breuckelen in Kings County. Revokes all former wills and codicils. To Dirck Paulus, eldest son by former wife Geertje Williamse, one piece of eight. To Dirck Pauluson and also to children of Lysbeth Paylyssen, £25. Executor not named. Witnesses: Thomas Lambertsen, John Gertse Dorlandt. (Recorded Kings co. Deeds, Lib. 1, p.278).¹²

GEERTJE WILLIAMSE was probably born between 1625 and 1630. She probably died before 1652.

Children of **Paulus' Dirckszen** and **Geertje Williamse** were:

- + 2 i. Dirck² Poulussen was born say 1647 (assuming age 25 when married). He married **Eechtje Teunise Covert**, daughter of **Teunis Covert** and **Barbara Lucas**, say 1672. He married second before Apr 1685 **Sara Yates**. He died between 19 Nov 1722 and 22 Dec 1730.

Children of **Paulus' Dirckszen** and **Jannetje Jans** were as follows:

- + 3 i. Elisabeth² Poulussen was born say 1653 (assumes age 20 at marriage). She married first say 1673 **Paulus Michielszen Van der Voort**, son of **Michiel Pauluszen** and **Marritje Jorise Rapalje**. She married second Amersfort, Kings Co., Long Island, New York, on 26 Apr 1685 **Klaas Barendsz Blom**.

- 4 ii. Geertruyd Pauluse was baptized on 2 Sep 1654 Reformed Dutch Church, New Amsterdam; sponsors Barbel Gysberts, Elsje Wessels.¹³

On 29 Mar 1688 Not mentioned in her father's will, although apparently living at the time.¹⁴ She witnessed the baptism of Sarah Hoff, daughter of Dirck Poulussen and Sara Yates, on 27 May 1688 Old First Dutch Reformed Church of Brooklyn, Brooklyn, Kings Co., Long Island, New York, (witnesses: Willem Pos, Geertje Poulus).¹⁵

2. DIRCK² POULUSSEN (Paulus' Dirckszen) was born say 1647 (assuming age 25 when married). He married **Eechtje Teunise Covert**, daughter of **Teunis Covert** and **Barbara Lucas**, say 1672.¹⁶ He married second before Apr 1685 **Sara Yates**.¹⁷ He died between 19 Nov 1722 and 22 Dec 1730; (date of will and proving).¹⁸

Also known as **Derick Hoff**.¹⁹ He appeared on the assessment list of Breuckelen, Kings Co., Long Island, New York, in 1676 Dierck Pauluse, 1 poll 2 horses 4 cows 4 do of 2 yrs 3 do of 1 yr for £76.10, 12 morgens land & valley for £24.²⁰ He was on the rate list Jamaica, Queens Co., Long Island, New York, in 1683 Derick Powleson, 2 horse, 6 cows, 22 land, 1 head, £107.10.00.²¹ He was named in his father's will dated on 29 Mar 1688 "Dirck Paulus, eldest son by former wife Geertie Williamse."²² He appeared on the census in 1698 Flushing, Queens Co., Long Island, New York, Dutch Inhabitants, Dirick Poules & Sarah his wife, 8 children: Peter, Thynis, Rich'd, Wm, Jon, Charles, Sarah, one negro Tom.²³ He witnessed the will of **Johannes Teunisz Covert** on 19 May 1719; proved 1 Apr 1723. John Koevers (Kuvers) of Millstone, Somerset Co., yeoman. Wife Jane, sole executrix. Children: Tunis, Bergon, Lucas, Catherine Bird, Orianchy Courser, Jane, Marry and Bathsheba. Real and personal estate. Wit.: Richard Hoff, Pieter Hoff, Aaron Louzada.²⁴ In 1722 **Dirck Poulussen** resided Maidenhead, Hunterdon Co., New Jersey.²⁵ His will was dated on 19 Nov 1722 proved 22 Dec 1730. Derick Hoff of Maidenhead, Hunterdon Co., New Jersey. Names children William, Sarah Anderson, Richard, Thomas, Powell, John, Charles, Joseph, Benjamin, Sarah Hoff, Mary Gary (both Sarahs are called daughters, the second may be in error for his wife, Sarah). Real and personal estate. Executors: sons John and Powell. Wit.: John Albade, Rut Johnson, Hannah Johnson. (Lib. 3, p. 108).²⁶ Inventory of estate taken on 7 Apr 1748 £117.3.5. Includes debts due from a list of persons including son Peter Huff.²⁷

EECHTJE TEUNISE COVERT was born say 1652 (assumes age 20 at marriage). She probably died between 1681 and 1684 Kings Co., Long Island, New York. Also known as **Eechtje Teunis**.²⁸

Children of **Dirck² Poulussen** and **Eechtje Teunise Covert** were as follows:

- + 5 i. Powell³ Hoff was born say 1673 (assumes age 25 at marriage, most likely first son, named for paternal grandfather). He married **Rachel** (___) in 1697/98. He died between 16 Nov 1749 and 27 Feb 1750.
- + 6 ii. Teunis Hoff was born say 1678 (most likely second son, named for maternal grandfather). He married **Jannetje** (___). He died between 13 Feb 1732 and 2 Apr 1733.
- + 7 iii. Pieter Hoff was probably born between 1678 and 1682 Brooklyn, Kings Co., Long Island, New York. He married **Catharina Brokaw**, daughter of **Bourgon Brokaw** and **Cathalyn Leafteber**, circa 1704.
- 8 iv. Johannes Dirckszen was baptized on 23 May 1680 Old First Dutch Reformed Church of Brooklyn, Brooklyn, Kings Co., Long Island, New York; witnesses: Teunis Jansen Coevers, Arent Fredericksen, Jannitjen Teunis, Jannitjen Klaes van Leendersloot.²⁹ He died before Mar 1692.
- 9 v. Wilhelmus Dirckszen was baptized on 23 May 1680 Old First Dutch Reformed Church of Brooklyn, Brooklyn, Kings Co., Long Island, New York; witnesses: Teunis Jansen Coevers, Arent Fredericksen, Jannitjen Teunis, Jannitjen Klaes van Leendersloot.³⁰ He died before Apr 1685.

SARA YATES. Also known as **Sara Willems**.³¹ Also known as **Sara Jeets**.³² Also known as **Sara Jitee**.³³

Children of **Dirck² Poulussen** and **Sara Yates** were as follows:

- + 10 i. Willem³ Hoff was baptized on 20 Apr 1685 Old First Dutch Reformed Church of Brooklyn, Brooklyn, Kings Co., Long Island, New York. He married **Elizabeth** (___). He died between 30 Oct 1742 and 20 Nov 1746.
- 11 ii. Richard Hoff was baptized on 29 Aug 1686 Old First Dutch Reformed Church of Brooklyn, Brooklyn, Kings Co., Long Island, New York; witnesses: Poulus Dickson, Elisabeth Poulussen.³⁴ He married Ann (___).³⁵

He was also known by the patronymic **DIRCK DIRCKSZEN**. Also known as **DERRICK HUFF**.³⁶ He was named in his father's will dated on 19 Nov 1722.³⁷ His will was dated on 22 Oct 1747 proved 29 Mar 1748. Derrick Huff of Kingston, late of the City of New Brunswick, Middlesex County, blacksmith. Estate to his wife for the maintenance of two children (daughters, but not named). Executors: wife Ann and friend Jedediah Higgins. Wit.: Ja. Leonard, Thomas Atchley and Jno. Dally. Ann Huff, the widow, renounced as executrix in favor of Jedediah Higgins in presence of Robert Rolfe. (Hunterdon Co. Lib. 5, p. 448).³⁸ Inventory of estate taken on 21 Feb 1750/51 £119.1.11 1/2, includes a list from who money is due. Signed by Jedediah Higgins.³⁹ On 11 Oct 1755 Account of Jedediah Higgins, acting executor, mentions Francis Bowes, Samuel Johnson, David Davis, Andrew Reed, Fregift Stout, Fredrick Vanlue, Peter Johnson, Mathias Vandike, Jno. Dagworthy, Thomas Ashly, John Berrian.⁴⁰

ANN (___) named in her husband's will on 22 Oct 1747 made an executor, renounced 29 March 1748.⁴¹

- 12 iii. Sarah Hoff was baptized on 27 May 1688 Old First Dutch Reformed Church of Brooklyn, Brooklyn, Kings Co., Long Island, New York; witnesses: Willem Pos, Geertje Poulus.⁴² She married (___) Anderson.⁴³

She was named in her father's will dated on 19 Nov 1722.⁴⁴

- + 13 iv. Thomas Hoff was baptized on 6 Apr 1690 Old First Dutch Reformed Church of Brooklyn, Brooklyn, Kings Co., Long Island, New York. He died between 13 Aug 1770 and 29 May 1771.
- 14 v. Jan Hoff was baptized on 13 Mar 1692 Old First Dutch Reformed Church of Brooklyn, Brooklyn, Kings Co., Long Island, New York; witnesses: Teunis Jansen Coevers, Elisabeth Hedlock.⁴⁵
He was also known by the patronymic **JAN DIRCKSZEN**. He appeared on the census in 1698 Flushing, Queens Co., Long Island, New York, child of Dirick Poules.⁴⁶ He was named in his father's will dated on 19 Nov 1722.⁴⁷
- + 15 vi. Charles Hoff was born before 1698. He married **Angelica (___)**. He died between 2 Jun 1755 and 3 Jan 1764.
- 16 vii. Mary Hoff was born after 1698 (not found on 1698 census). She married (___) Gary.
She was named in her father's will dated on 19 Nov 1722.⁴⁸
- 17 viii. Joseph Hoff was born after 1698 (not found on 1698 census).
Also known as **JOSEPH HUFF**.⁴⁹ He was named in his father's will dated on 19 Nov 1722.⁵⁰ Administration of Joseph Hoff's estate was granted on 7 Dec 1769 estate of Joseph Huff of Somerset County, died intestate, granted to John Van Derveer. Fellowbondsmen: Jacobus Van Derveer, both of said Co. Wit.: William Redord Crawford. Lib. K, p. 142.⁵¹ Inventory of estate taken on 12 Dec 1769 £15.7.0, made by Gerret Voorhees and Stephen Hunt.⁵²
- 18 ix. Benjamin Hoff was born after 1698 (not found on 1698 census).
He was named in his father's will dated on 19 Nov 1722.⁵³

3. ELISABETH² POULUSSEN (Paulus¹ Dirckszen) was born say 1653 (assumes age 20 at marriage). She married first say 1673 **Paulus Michielszen Van der Voort**, son of **Michiel Pauluszen** and **Marritje Jorise Rapalje**.⁵⁴ She married second Amersfort, Kings Co., Long Island, New York, on 26 Apr 1685 **Klaas Barendsz Blom**.⁵⁵

She witnessed the baptism of **Richard Hoff**, son of **Dirck Poulussen** and **Sara Yates**, on 29 Aug 1686 Old First Dutch Reformed Church of Brooklyn, Brooklyn, Kings Co., Long Island, New York, (witnesses: Poulus Dickson, Elisabeth Poulussen).⁵⁶ She was named in her father's will dated on 29 Mar 1688 "to the children of Lysbeth Paylyssen."⁵⁷

PAULUS MICHIELSZEN VAN DER VOORT was baptized on 3 Jan 1649 Reformed Dutch Church, New Amsterdam; sponsors Joris Rapalje en s.h.v.⁵⁸ He died on 2 Jun 1681.⁵⁹ Also known as **Paulus Michielszen**.⁶⁰

Children of **Elisabeth² Poulussen** and **Paulus Michielszen Van der Voort** were as follows:

- + 19 i. Michiel³ van der Voort was born circa 1674. He married **Styntje Schamp** say 1698.
- 20 ii. John Van der Voort was possibly baptized on 1 Apr 1678 Brooklyn, Kings Co., Long Island, New York, sponsors Jeronijmus Rapalie, Katalijnte Rapalie (K: Jan, parents not recorded).⁶¹

5. POWELL³ HOFF (Dirck² Poulussen, Paulus¹ Dirckszen) was born say 1673 (assumes age 25 at marriage, most likely first son, named for paternal grandfather). He married **Rachel (___)** in 1697/98. He died between 16 Nov 1749 and 27 Feb 1750.

He was also known by the patronymic **Paulus Dirckszen**. He appeared on the census in 1698 Flushing, Queens Co., Long Island, New York, Dutch Inhabitants. Powell Hoff & Rachel his wife, no children.⁶⁴ He was named in his father's will dated on 19 Nov 1722.⁶⁵ "meadow between Samuel Hunt's widow and Powell Huff's," is mentioned in the will of Capt. Ralph Hunt of Maidenhead, Hunterdon County, 5 Nov 1732.⁶⁶ In 1749 **Powell Hoff** resided Hopewell, Hunterdon Co., New Jersey.⁶⁷ His will was dated on 16 Nov 1749 proved 28 Feb 1750. Powell Hoff of Hopewell, Hunterdon Co., yeoman. Names children Hannah, Richard, Rachel and Isaac. Executor: son Richard. Wit.: Thomas Sutton, Richard Phillips and John Redford. (Lib. 7, p. 53).⁶⁸ Inventory of estate taken on 27 Feb 1750/51 £18.6.4, made by Timothy Titus and Richard Phillips.⁶⁹

Children of **Powell³ Hoff** and **Rachel (___)** were as follows:

- 24 i. Rachel⁴ Hoff was named in her father's will dated on 16 Nov 1749.⁷⁰
- 25 ii. Hannah Hoff was named in her father's will dated on 16 Nov 1749.⁷¹
- 26 iii. Richard Hoff was named in his father's will dated on 16 Nov 1749.⁷²
- 27 iv. Isaac Hoff was named in his father's will dated on 16 Nov 1749.⁷³
- 28 v. Thomas Hoff was baptized on 11 Aug 1700 Old First Dutch Reformed Church of Brooklyn, Brooklyn, Kings Co., Long Island, New York; witnesses: Gabriel Sprong, Geertruy his wife.⁷⁴
Also known as **TAMMES PAULUSSEN**.⁷⁵ Thomas is not named in his father's will dated 16 Nov 1749.⁷⁶

6. TEUNIS³ HOFF (Dirck² Poulussen, Paulus¹ Dirckszen) was born say 1678 (most likely second son, named for maternal grandfather). He married **Jannetje (___)**.⁷⁷ He died between 13 Feb 1732 and 2 Apr 1733; (dates of will and proving).⁷⁸

He was also known by the patronymic **Teunis Dirckszen**. He appeared on the census in 1698 Flushing, Queens Co., Long Island, New York, a child of Dirick Poules.⁷⁹ He witnessed the baptism of **Marytje Sprong**, daughter of **Gabriel Sprong** and **Geertruit (___)**, on 7 Aug 1705 Old First Dutch Reformed Church of Brooklyn, Brooklyn, Kings Co., Long Island, New York, (witnesses: Theunis Hof, Maritje Titus).⁸⁰ In 1732 **Teunis Hoff** resided Somerset Co., New Jersey.⁸¹ His will was dated on 13 Feb 1732 proved 2 Apr 1733. Tunis Hoff of Somerset Co., weaver. Wife, Jane, sole executrix and real and personal estate, including house and lot at "Rockey Hill," she to pay my eldest son Richard, 20 shillings. Wit.: Joseph Leigh, Joseph Badcock, Jane Badcock. Lib. B, page 391.⁸²

JANNETJE (___) named in her husband's will on 13 Feb 1732 made sole executrix.⁸³

Children of **Teunis³ Hoff** and **Jannetje (___)** were as follows:

- 29 i. Jannetie⁴ Hoff was baptized on 5 Aug 1712 Reformed Dutch Church, Jamaica, Queens Co., Long Island, New York; sponsors Jan Bras, Sara Bras.⁸⁴
- + 30 ii. Anthony Huff was possibly born between 1715 and 1720. He married **Anne (___)**. He died between 24 Aug 1750 and 15 Sep 1750.
- 31 iii. Richard Hoff was probably born before 1718.
He was named in his father's will dated on 13 Feb 1732.⁸⁵
- 32 iv. Jan Hoff was baptized on 21 Sep 1718 Reformed Dutch Church, Jamaica, Queens Co., Long Island, New York; sponsors Jan Bras, Sara Bras.⁸⁶

7. PIETER³ HOFF (Dirck² Poulussen, Paulus¹ Dirckszen) was probably born between 1678 and 1682 Brooklyn, Kings Co., Long Island, New York. He married **Catharina Brokaw**, daughter of **Bourgon Brokaw** and **Cathalyn Leaffeber**, circa 1704.⁸⁷

Also known as **Peter Huff**.⁸⁸ He appeared on the census in 1698 Flushing, Queens Co., Long Island, New York, child of Dirick Poules.⁸⁹ He witnessed the will of **Johannes Teunisz Covert** on 19 May 1719; proved 1 Apr 1723. John Koevers (Kuvers) of Millstone, Somerset Co., yeoman. Wife Jane, sole executrix. Children: Tunis, Bergon, Lucas, Catherine Bird, Orianchy Courser, Jane, Marry and Bathsheba. Real and personal estate. Wit.: Richard Hoff, Pieter Hoff, Aaron Louzada.⁹⁰ His will was dated on 3 May 1748.⁹¹

CATHARINA BROKAW was baptized on 14 Mar 1686 Reformed Dutch Church, New York City, New York.⁹²

Children of **Pieter³ Hoff** and **Catharina Brokaw** were as follows:

- + 35 iii. Dirck Hoff was baptized on 26 Oct 1709 Reformed Dutch Church, Raritan (Somerville), Somerset Co., New Jersey. He married **Cornelia (___)**.
- 36 iv. Catharina Hoff was baptized on 30 Apr 1712 Reformed Dutch Church, Raritan (Somerville), Somerset Co., New Jersey; witnesses: Willem Odyn and wife.⁹⁵ She married Henry Stevens.⁹⁶
Also known as **KATALEYN HOFF**.⁹⁷
- 37 v. Egjen Hoff was baptized on 18 May 1715 Reformed Dutch Church, Raritan (Somerville), Somerset Co., New Jersey; witnesses: Hans Koevers, Aeltie Spieten.⁹⁸ She married Brogun Brokaw.⁹⁹

Also known as **JANNETJE HOFF**.¹⁰⁰

- + 38 vi. Gertrude Hoff was baptized on 31 Jul 1717 Reformed Dutch Church, Raritan (Somerville), Somerset Co., New Jersey. She married **Abraham Tietsort**.
- + 39 vii. Isaac Hoff was baptized on 28 Feb 1720 Reformed Dutch Church, Raritan (Somerville), Somerset Co., New Jersey. He married **Catharina Van Nest**, daughter of **Peter Van Nest** and **Magdalena Stoll**. He died between 7 May 1790 and 14 Feb 1792.
- + 40 viii. John Hoff was born circa 1723 Somerset Co., New Jersey. He married **Antje Van Nest**, daughter of **Peter Van Nest** and **Magdalena Stoll**. He died between 4 Apr 1780 and 16 Apr 1781.
- 41 ix. Elizabeth Hoff was baptized on 25 Jan 1728 Harlingen Reformed Dutch Church, Somerset Co., New Jersey; witnesses: John Brokaw, Junr. & Catherine Bord.¹⁰¹ She probably married Abraham Brokaw.¹⁰²

10. WILLEM³ HOFF (Dirck² Poulussen, Paulus¹ Dirckszen) was baptized on 20 Apr 1685 Old First Dutch Reformed Church of Brooklyn, Brooklyn, Kings Co., Long Island, New York; (no witnesses recorded).¹⁰³ He married **Elizabeth (___)**.¹⁰⁴ He died between 30 Oct 1742 and 20 Nov 1746; (dates of will and proving).¹⁰⁵

He was also known by the patronymic **Willem Dirckszen**. He appeared on the census in 1698 Flushing, Queens Co., Long Island, New York, child of Dirick Poules.¹⁰⁶ He was named in his father's will dated on 19 Nov 1722.¹⁰⁷ In 1742 **Willem Hoff** resided Middletown, Monmouth Co., New Jersey.¹⁰⁸ His will was dated on 30 Oct 1742 proved 20 Nov 1746. William Hoff of Middletown Twp., Monmouth Co., yeoman. Names wife, Elizabeth, executrix. Son, William. Daughter Catherine Dorset. "Three youngest children." Wit.: James Mott, Jarret Wall, Garsham Walling. Lib. D, p. 435.¹⁰⁹ Inventory of estate taken on 11 Dec 1746 £386.04.0, includes two guns and a negro man. Made by James Mott and Gisbert Vanbrackel.¹¹⁰

ELIZABETH (___) was probably born between 1685 and 1695.
