and each and every of our Heirs, Executors and Administrators, jointly and
severally, firmly by these presents.

Sealed with our seals and dated the 29th day of December, A. D.
One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty-five.

The Condition of the above obligation is such, That if hereafter we lawful marriedly
Martin D. Bassett and Eliza A. Northcutt,
should not be joined together in the Matrimony, then this obligation
to be void; otherwise, to remain in full force and virtue.
