He married **Dorothea Wilhelmine Margaret Backhaus** in Germany. She was born September 21, 1813 in Preußen, Germany, and died September 21, 1905 in New Melle, Saint Charles County, Missouri.

Behrend Ameling arrived in New Orleans, Louisiana on December 1, 1853 aboard the ship "Ernestine". He is listed as a Merchant from Hannover and is listed as Behrend Ameling, age 42, male, Dorothea Ameling, age 42, female, Doris Ameling, age 12, male, Hanne Ameling, age 9, female. Their destination is listed as St. Louis. (New Orleans Passenger Lists, 1820-1945, National Archives' Series Number: M259\_39).

I have been unable to find Dorothea on earlier census even though she is listed as not deceased until 1905. I have found the below family which would work with the ages but there is a different last name than Almeling.
