Lemuel Royce** and **3. Ame Or Anne/Anna**. She married **(1) James Bacon**^{5,6} 23 Nov 1825 in Charlestown, New Hampshire, Old Fort #4, Sullivan County^{7,8}. He was born 17 Jan 1802 in Dudley, Massachusetts^{9,10,11}, and died 10 Aug 1876 in Tioga County, Cherry Flats, Pennsylvania¹². He was the son of John Bacon and Amity Brown.

The information is from headstones in Cherry Flats, Pennsylvania, and the Covington 1850 census.

1870 Covington census has Norman and Sophia, ages 61 and 58 respectively, living one house away from James and Fidelia. He was a farmer, born in Vermont, and she was born in Pennsylvania.

Further away, another Rockwell family lived. A. W. Rockwell, age 44, born in Pennsylvania; his wife Cynthia (I think it's his wife), age 22, born in Pennsylvania, and a child Wilber, age 2.

According to the will of Fidelia Bacon, she left everything to her "daughter" Amy Alvira Woodford. This daughter may possibly be the one named Elvina in the 1850 census. The spelling of the names changes from one document to another. For instance, in Fidelia's will, her name is officially spelled "Phidelia". It is also spelled that way in her land dealings. However, she signs her name "Fidelia".

Fort 4, Charlestown, NH was built to defend towns below in Massachusetts from French and Indians attack...Massachusetts built forts in the frontiers of NH (then a part of MA) in the early 1700s. The French and Indians were reaching the towns of MA by coming down the CT River and the Nashua Rivers. The Fort 4 was built beside the CT River. It was only one of many forts in that area built early 1700s.

Langdon is bordered on the north by Charlestown, east by Acworth, south by Alstead and Walpole, and on the west by Walpole and Charlestown. The Cold River pages south-west through the town. The principle village is

three miles east from Connecticut Rover and six from Bellows Falls.

Langdon was named in honor of Gov. John Langdon. The first settlers were Seth Walker, Nathaniel Rice and Jonathan Williard in 1773.

LEMUEL ROYCE is said to have been the last survivor of the Revolutionary soldiers, originally belonging to Charlestown. At the time of the battle of Bennington, he was a member of Capt. Abel Walker's company, but enlisted Feb. 4th, 1778, into Capt. Isaac Farwell's in which he continued nearly if not quite through the war. He was fond of telling in his advanced age of the battles in which he had been engaged, and appears to have been proud of having been selected as one of the guards at the execution of Major Andre, whose gentlemanly bearing and courage filled him with such admiration that he named one of his children after him. I have been unable to obtain a record either of his death or his marriage. I have gathered from aged persons the following names of his children.

He appears to have moved from Charlestown to Langdon about 1790, and where it is believed he remained most of his after life. His war record states he was aged 23 in 1778, and 79 years old in 1818.

I'm not sure about that last statement. It seems to conflict with his actual pension records.

Chapter 2, p.15 The anticipated war between England and France begins.

To appreciate the situation of the settlers of Fort 4, it is necessary to have some knowledge of the progress which the country had made at that time.

Beginning then, at Boston (MA) at that time the principal place in New England, we must not imagine it as containing its tens of thousands of inhabitants, but a taxable population of about eighteen hundred; for this, according to Holmes, was the number it contained in 1742. The same writer puts down the number of its dwelling houses as seven hundred and nineteen. From this we shall immediately perceive that it is not the Boston of our present ideas. In about the same year, the taxable persons in the county of Worcester were about three thousand two hundred. The settlement most easily reached was at Northfield, MA which was

on the Connecticut River, about forty-five miles below; for though there were a few inhabitants at Upper Ashuelot, (now Keene) and Lower Ashuelot (now Swanzey) there was no other way, at the time, of reaching them except by way of Fort Dummer.

The nearest settlements within the present limits of New Hampshire with the exception of those already mentioned were on the Merrimac and its branches. These were Penacook (now Concord), Suncook (now Pembroke) Contoocook (now Boscaawen) New Hopkinton (now Hopkinton) Souhegan East (now Merrimac) Souhegan West (now Amherst). Hollis was also settled under the name of Nissitissit, or the West Parish of Dunstable.

West of the Connecticut, there were no settlements in the territory, now included in the State of Vermont, with the exception of Fort Dummer; and on the north, there were none this side of the borders of Canada.

No. 4, was, therefore, the most advanced frontier settlement, environed by deep forests on every side and the most exposed to the enemy in case of a French or Indian war, which, owing to the disturbed relations of France and England, was at any time probable. Indeed, it was the apprehension of such a war that had long been the means of restraining emigration and preventing the progress of settlements on the Connecticut River, the lands on which were reputed to be exceedingly desirable. But the time at length arrived, when circumstances combined to create sufficient motives to induce their occupation, notwithstanding disastrous results which had attended nearly all previous settlements on the river.

The township of No. 4 was granted originally by Massachusetts but that, subsequently, by the decision of the King George 2nd - it was found to lie within the boundaries of New Hampshire and that on learning this, the proprietors had petitioned the King to have this township set back again under the jurisdiction of Massachusetts. This was in September 1740 and before the next meeting, held September 1, 1742, most of the proprietors had disposed of their interests in the township probably owing to the doubtful character of their titles. Only three of the original proprietors became settlers. These were Captain Phineas Stevens, Lieutenant Ephraim Wetherbe and Stephen Farnsworth. A few others held their titles for awhile but eventually disposed of them. The settlement of Fort 4 was very slow, as in 1744 there were not more than nine or ten families.

The first settlement of No. 4 was made by three brothers, Samuel, David and Stephen Farnsworth in 1740. They were natives of Groton, MA. But at the time of their removal to No. 4, they resided at Lunenburg, MA (Turkey Hills). They were soon followed by Isaac Parker and sons, and Obadiah Sartwell (Sawtell) from Groton, MA and John Hastings of Hatfield, MA and Moses Willard of Lunenburg and Phineas Stevens of Rutland, MA.

From Chronology of Mansfield, Connecticut 1702 - 1972, compiled by the History Workshop of the Mansfield Historical Society

Preceding the incorporation of Mansfield as a separate town in 1703, the sixteen legatees of Joshua (third son of the Indian Sachem Uncas) divided the tract of land according to the allotments specified in his will, and many of their parcels are sold to the earliest settlers.

Soon these settlers experience the hardships of crossing the river (Natchaug) to attend church services in Windham Center (Hither Place) and the residents of Ponde Place (now Mansfield Center) agree to petition the General Assembly of Connecticut for incorporation as a separate town. The Assembly grants this request in 1703, and the town is named Mansfield after Major Moses Mansfield of New Haven, who supposedly "routed a body of hostile Indians" in the general area.

May 30, 1693 - Town meeting enrolls five new inhabitants in Ponde Place. John Arnold was one of them, a former schoolmaster in Norwich. (pg. 12)

1693 - J. Allen, Peter Cross, John Arnold, Samuel Lincoln, and John Royce buy house lots in Ponde Place. (pg. 12)

May, 1703 - Pondtown is incorporated by the General Court under the name of Mansfield. (pg. 16)

October 20, 1703 - The charter is granted to the following as proprietors of the town:John Arnold, John Royce.....

February 15, 1732 - Dr. Nathan Arnold, one of Mansfield's earliest doctors, is born on this day. (pg. 23)
