Chapter 21 John Stewart Family 1809 - 1881

John Stewart was born in 1809 and died in 1881. ¹ John married **Beneta Davis Wetherington**, the daughter of Jesse Wetherington, on February 6, 1839 in Craven County. ² Beneta was born in 1820 and died in 1903. ³ John Stewart and Beneta Wetherington Stewart are buried in the Stewart Cemetery at Tuscarora. ⁴

LDS Internet records report John Stewart's parents as **Ellenor Stewart** and **John Fonville**. ⁵ There is not a marriage recorded in Craven County for Ellenor, however Ellenor Stewart, born about 1776, appears in the 1850 Craven census in the household of James Stewart, John's brother. ⁶

John Stewart's other brother was **William Riley Stewart** who moved to Tennessee and married and then moved to California where he died. ⁷ Bible records indicate that John Stewart was the son of **William Stewart** and **Nellie Stewart** and Nellie was the daughter of **Daniel Stewart**, a soldier of the Revolution. William Stewart was drowned at sea. ⁸




Figure 46 John Stewart Family Tree
