James C. Martin went to the State of Georgia in the year of our Lord, and settled at ^(Lumpkin) Leunkin, County of ^(Stewart) Steward near the Glaboma river where he owned a plantation. In July 1840 he was taken sick, with what they call there the Strangers Fever, nearly what we call Yellow Fever, and after a few days of severe suffering died July 31, 1840, the Triumphant Death of a Christian rejoicing in the Lord.
