

- (1) Pg. 17. John Folsom(1), bapt. 1615 in Hingham, England. (a town about 14 Mi. W.S.W. of Norwich & 97 Mi. N.E. of London) m. 4 Oct. 1636, Mary, oldest ch. of Edward & Mary(Clark)Gilman. d. at Exeter, N.H. 27 Dec. 1681. His widow survived him by 8/10 years. Their childrens names are found in the diary of Rev. Peter Hobart, of Hingham, Mass., who recorded the date on which he bapt. each of them.
- (2) 1. Samuel(2), bapt. on 3 Oct. 1641. m. 22 Dec. 1663, Mary, dau. of Judge Henry Robie, of Hampton. d. 1700. Suppose he was b. 1638-9.
- (3) 2. John(2), b. 1640-41. bapt. 3 Oct. 1641. Called "Deacon John". m. 10 Nov. 1675, Abigail, dau. of Abraham Perkins, of Hampton. Made Will 24 Nov. 1715. d. before 6 Dec. 1715, aged about 75 yrs.
- (4) 3. Nathaniel(2), bapt. 2 June 1644. m. (1) 9 June 1674, Hannah, dau. of John Farrow, of Ipswich, Mass. In 1677, admitted as citizen of Exeter, where he was active in town affairs.
- (5) 4. Israel(2), bapt. 26 Apr. 1646.
- (6) 5. Peter(2), bapt. 8 Apr. 1649. m. 6 May 1678. Susanna Cousins (Coffee, Kelly says) of Wells Me. (see #6, Pg. 25)
6. Mary(2), bapt. 13 Apr. 1651. m. June 1672, George Marsh, son of Hugh, of Newberry, Mass. On 18 Mar. 1672, her father gave (son & dau., George & Mary) 100 acres of land in south part of Exeter. They had 13 Ch. Father, George, d. in 1699. ag. 53yrs.
- (7) 7. Ephram(2), b. Hingham records show, probably 23 Feb. 1654 O.S. bapt. 25 Feb. 1654. m. Phaltiel, dau. of Lt. Ralph Hall, of Dover. Lived in part of Exeter called So. Newmarket. Was shot by Indians as he was riding home from Exeter, on 11 June 1709. There were 7 children. His widow lived 25 yrs. after his death.

Lt. Peter Folsom(2), (John(1). 1649 - 1717. m. 6 May 1678, Susanna Cousins, (Coffee, Kelly says) of Wells, Me. had, born in Exeter -
1. Elizabeth(3), m. (1) 13 Sept. 1704, Lt. Samuel Colcord of Kingston. They had 5 ch.
Mrs. Elizabeth Colcord(3), m. (2) 19 Aug. 1718, Lt. Samuel Sanborn, of Kingston, and had 3 ch. She d. 8 Apr. 1756.
2. Susanna(3), m. Caleb(3), son of Moses(2)Gilman, grandson of Edward(1)Gilman. Had David(4) & Caleb(4)Gilman.
3. Mary(3), m. Joseph Thing. b. Mar. 1684. d. D. Mar. 1784. Had 6 ch.
- (15)4. Peter(3), b. abt. 1682. m. Catherine(3), dau. of Hon. John(2) Gilman, grand-dau. of Edward(1)Gilman. He d. 1718. Left 6 ch. Widow m. Richard Calley, of Stratham. no ch.
- (16)5. John(3), b. 1685?. M. (1) Hannah, dau. of James Gilman. m.(2) Sarah Lyford??. Had 7 ch. In 1722 he is called J. Folsom, Jr. d. 1757 Gilmanton. (Mary--- possible 3rd wife.
- (17)6. Benjamin(3), b. in Exeter 1696. d. March 1752, ag. 56 yrs. m. Rachel, dau. of James Gilman, grand-dau. of Moses Gilman, b. 1699. She d. Mar. 1785. He left 2 ch.

- (16) Pg. 38, John Folsom(3), Peter(2), John(I). 1685 - 1757. Lived in N.W. part of Exeter, owning land in New Market & Epping. m. (I) Hannah, dau. of James Gilman. (2) Sarah Lyford?, dau. of Francis(I), grand-dau. of Capt. Theophilus Dudley, from whom his children, Sarah & Susanna, inherited lands, which they deeded, in 1748, and 10 Oct. 1749, to others. She d. before 1748. Wife at his death was Mary----?. His ch. born in Exeter were -
- (45) 1. Peter(4), b. 1718. m. Hannah Morrison. Lived in part of Newmarket called Piscassic, near Exeter line. Part of farm in Exeter, where he paid taxes many years. His lands described in his father's will. Cellar remains where house stood. Had 12 ch., and late in life, followed them to Gilmanton, where he made will in 1800. d. 1815, aged 97.
2. Elizabeth(4), m. ----Thirston. Had son, John T., named in her Father's will, 1756.
3. Mary(4), m. William(4), son of Ephrim(3) Folsom, (Eph.(2)., of Newmarket. Had 10 ch. Made will in 1786. d. 1787.
- (46) 4. Joshua(4), b. 1719. m. 1743?, Abi Mead, b. 1722, d. Epping 1796. Had 7 ch. Will dated 2 Dec. 1793. d. 20 Dec. 1793, ag. 74yrs.
5. Sarah(4), m. Abraham(4) Folsom, (Abr.(3), Jn(2).) Moved to Epping. Had 2 sons. -
1. Abraham - moved to Meridith
2. Josiah - stayed in Epping ----and 2 daus.
Parents both living in Apr. 1795. 10 June 1800, 1 dau., Anna, relinquished her rights to estate of father, Abraham Folsom, late of Epping, dec'd.
6. Susanna(4), m. Nathaniel Bean, of Exeter & Warner. She was mother of Nathaniel Bean, Esq., of Warner. In 1777, a Susannah, dau. of John Folsom, had m. Richard Moulton, of Hampton Falls, and deeded land received from her father to Josiah Folsom.
- (47) 7. Josiah, Jr.(4), b. 25 Sept. 1725, inherited the homestead. He m., in Kensington, 9 or 17 May 1755-54, widow Martha Gould, dau. of Jere Eastman, b. 1727, d. 27 Feb. 1804. Had 8 ch. Made his will in 1816. d. 27 July 1820, near age 95.
- (45) Pg. 68. Peter Folsom(4), (Jn.(3), Pe(2), Jn.(I)). 1718 - 1815, and his wife Hannah Morrison had, b. in Newmarket, near Exeter line, 12 children -
1. Benjamin(5), b. 5 Sept. 1740. Had a dau. Hannah, who m. ----Pease. Benjamin(5) killed by falling tree, Dec. 1773, in Wolfborough.
2. Mary(5), b. 1742. d. infant.
3. Peter(5), b. 1744. d. infant.
- (93) 4. Peter(5), b. 8 Aug. 1745. Called Lt. Peter. m.(I) Betsey, dau. of Oliver Calef, of Exeter. Removed from Newmarket to Gilmanton in Mar. 1773. d. there Mar. 1827. He m.(2) Widow Elizabeth Bean. He had 13 children.
5. Hannah(5), b. 1747. d. young.
6. Lydia(5), b. 22 Feb. 1749. d. young.
7. Judith(5), b. 2 feb. 1751.
8. Mary(5)(Polly), b. 17 June 1754. m. ----Swett.
9. Hannah(5), b. 10 Oct. 1756. m.(I)----Fifield, (2)---Carrol.
10. John Folsom(5), b. 29 Apr. 1759. m. Miss Weymouth, is said to have moved to Limerick, Me. from Newmarket. Had 9 ch. Was living in 1800, and named in his father's will. Drowned in Newport Lake, Newport, Me.
