Most of the stones weathered and broken, some undecipherable. Neglected.  
There are many rough hewn granite markers with no legible engraving.  
Several depressions that could be graves, but no stones. 2 stones way  
in back that are regular type monuments, but have no legible printing.

This list is all of the stones remaining in the cemetery, and is a  
composite list of my own, Alvah Carver's list, and one from Ernest  
Meader of the Madison Hist. Soc. dated 1968. Rec. Aug. 8, 1973.

Many of the stones have been completely destroyed.
