Cornet Joseph Parsons⁽¹⁾, came from England and in 1635 settled in Springfield, Mass., from which place he afterward moved to Northampton, Mass. He d. 9 Oct. 1683. m. Hartford, Conn., 26 Nov. 1646, Mary Bliss, dau. of Thomas and Margaret Bliss of Hartford. She d. 29 Jan. 1711-12, ag. 92 yrs., in Springfield. He was one of the witnesses to the deed from the Indians, dated 15 July 1636. He was an extensive land holder and a trader in furs.

Joseph⁽²⁾, (Joseph⁽¹⁾). b. Nov. 1647, in Springfield, Mass. d. 29 Nov. 1729. m. 17 March 1669 in Northampton, Mass., Elizabeth H. Strong, b. 24 Feb. 1648, dau. of John and Abigail (Ford) Strong, of Dorchester, Mass. She d. 12 May 1736, in Northampton. He was Justice of the Peace, and Captain of the Militia.
