ASSIGNEE'S BOND FILED.

Officials Now Ready to Investigate Crawford County Banks.

ENGLISH, Ind., Nov. 20. — The legal steps necessary to the appointment of an assignee for the settlement of the affairs of the defunct banks has been made, and the bond of R. C. Arnold for \$100,000 was filed this morning. The security was furnished by Messrs. Slaughter and Gilmour of Louisville, general agents of the National Security Company of New York, as is the case with the bond given by I. F. Johnson, assignee of the Royal Spoke Company, of Leavenworth for \$25,000.

Mr. Slaughter says that everything is now in readiness for the assignee's investigation. Congressman Zenor says that the report quoting him as saying depositors will be first was erroneous in every way, as he never made such a statement. All claimants will share alike in the settlement of the affairs, no class being preferred. The people have full confidence in the assignees, Arnold and Johnson, and Con-

THE BANK WRECKERS **WILLETT AND WEATHERS DISLIKE** **CRAWFORD COUNTY CLIMATE.**

Letter Received from One Says the Money of Three Banks Was Lost in Speculation.

LEAVENWORTH, Ind., Nov. 15. — There is still much excitement in this county over the failure of the banks at English, here and Marengo. It is rumored that President Weathers has telegraphed that he, Mrs. Weathers and Mrs. Willett will return at once and assign their properties for the benefit of the depositors. It is said Weathers guarantees to pay depositors 15 percent of their losses if they will assure him freedom from violence. He seems willing to do all he can to set the matter right. Willett has not been heard from, but many think he will not come back. Others say he will return and give up all his possessions to help pay out the indebtedness of the English bank and its two branches. Weathers's home has been in English since last spring, but he and his wife are heavy property holders here, where their greatest interest is. Since Weathers left, Friday morning, his wife has been in Leavenworth.

Willett and Weathers married the wealthy Holgran sisters of Meade County, Kentucky, several years ago, and it was with their wives' money they started the Citizens' Bank here. Later they organized the branches at Marengo and English, with Weathers president of all three and Willett cashier of the Citizens' Bank and vice president of the branches at Marengo and English. There is said to be about \$30,000 lost in the Citizens' Bank, but this does not begin to include Cashier Willett's liabilities. He was a large stockholder in the Cannelton Bank, practically owned the water and light companies, the spoke factory, and with Weathers owned the telephone company.

President John H. Weathers has made an assignment, turning over everything. Willett, the cashier, who absconded, has written his wife that he was the sole cause of the failure, which was due to bad speculation. There is no blame for the failure laid to Mr. Weathers, and he has the entire sympathy of the people. Weathers loss is set at \$50,000. The deposits will not reach over \$100,000 it is claimed.

MOB AT THE BANK DOORS **CITIZENS OF CRAWFORD COUNTY** **LOSE THEIR MONEY IN A DAY.**

Institutions at Leavenworth, Marengo and English Closed and \$100,000 in Deposits Gone.

ENGLISH, Ind., Nov. 13. — Crawford county was thrown into a high state of excitement this morning on the failure of the Leavenworth Bank and the banks at English and Marengo. These institutions have been under the management of R. H. Willett, Democratic chairman for this district, and the deposits in each of the banks were heavy. The trouble seems to have originated at the Leavenworth Bank, where Mr. Willett makes his headquarters. The Union National Bank of Louisville notified the Bank of Leavenworth Friday that it had overdrawn. Willett being away and nowhere to be found, the president of the bank, Hon. J. P. Weathers, was notified, who, after an investigation, ordered the banks closed until he could make an investigation. They have been trying to locate Willett, but have failed, he having last been seen in Louisville Thursday morning. The people at English, Marengo and Leavenworth have been gathering in a mob in front of their banks all day, but the cooler heads have kept down trouble. No one seems to be censured but Willett. His friends sent out a story that grief since his mother's death had unbalanced his mind. The deposits in the three banks will reach \$150,000. All the money collected by the county treasurer on the last installment of taxes was deposited in the Bank of English. The trustees of the different townships having their money deposited have been ordered by the county superintendent to stop their schools till an investigation can be made. Nearly every business man in the county was caught, some for large amounts.

Later developments in the bank failure show that all the collected taxes of Crawford and Perry counties were in the bank and its branches, and that thousands of dollars' worth of pension checks have been deposited during the last few days. County Treasurer Brown, of Crawford county, had \$10,000 on deposit, and the deposit of Trustee Beasley, of this township, exceeds \$2,500. Every trustee in this county is a depositor. It is now alleged that the failure was contemplated, and the feeling of indignation is so strong that a riot is possible. The lighter depositors are the more demonstrative. Treasurer Brown, who is an invalid, was prostrated on hearing of the failure, and fear is entertained of results. No statement of the assets and liabilities has been given out.

An Associated Press dispatch from Leavenworth says the deposits of the three banks are estimated to aggregate \$160,000. The wife of R. H. Willett, cashier of the parent bank, has received a letter from him stating that he has

almost lost his mind and that he will not return to the scene of financial diaster. Continuing, the dispatch says: "County officials and educational trustees are sufferers from the crash, and one death may be the direct result. Treasurer E. P. Brown, of Crawford county had upward of \$30,000 county funds deposited in the bank in this city. When told today of the failure he fainted, and tonight he is in a critical condition. The revenue collected for school purposes was all on deposit in the banks, and it is feared that all of the public schools in Crawford and Perry counties will have to be closed, as the trustees have lost all their money. The crash came without warning. As late as yesterday afternoon each of the banks continued to receive deposits, and when they failed to open their doors this morning there were scenes of great consternation among the business men, some of whom had deposited so closely yesterday afternoon that they did not even have change to begin business with this morning."

A dispatch from Cannelton, Ind., says that the bank at that place, a branch of the bank at English, Ind., which failed today, and which was reported as closed, is open and doing business.

Recent developments have put a very different face on the Crawford county bank failures from that first reported. Instead of a wholesale swindle impoverishing half the inhabitants of the county, it now appears that there was no deliberate dishonesty and all depositors are likely to be paid.
