Majestys Court of Prerogative in Ireland*

In the Name of God amen I Walter Stewart of EnnisKillen and County of Fermanagh being sick in body but perfect sound sense and memory calling to mind the mortality of souls that that it is appointed for all men once to die make this my last Will and Testament in manner and way as followeth – First I leave my soul to God Almighty hoping that thro' his Grace he will have mercy on me next I leave my body to be decently buried in the Church yard of EnnisKillen at the discrefsion of my Executors hereafter ment'd next I leave to my well beloved wife Jean Stewart my house and field in the Commons in during her life and after her decease I leave the same house and field to my daughter Jean Stewart and failing heirs of the said Jean Stewart I leave the said house and field to the heirs of Wm. Whitager and Christopher Beaty equally divided next I allow my daur Cathe Stewart to have the part of the said house now in her actual pofsefsion during her life paying the usual rent next I leave to my daur Alice Spotwood (sic) the sum of one shilling and one penny Lastly I appoint my wife Jean Stewart and William Stewart Esq. of Chanterhill Exors of this my last Will & Testament hereby revoking all Will or Wills heretofore made by me this only to be my last Will and Testament Given under my hand this 13th day of August 1804 – Walter Stewart (seal) Signed Sealed published and declared in the presence of us and in the presence of each other - Wm. Campbell - Richd. Bowles – Robt Frith

The last Will and Testament of Walter Stewart late of EnnisKillen in the County of Fermanagh deceased (having and soforth) was proved in common form of law and Probate therof granted by the Most Reverend Father William and soforth to Jane Stewart one of the Exors named in said Will she being first sworn by Commission saving the right of Wm Stewart the other Exor named in said Will also saving and soforth Dated the 12th day of May 1815 ---
