December 5th 1884

I Curd Cox do make and publish this as my last will and testament hereby revoked and making void all other wills by one at any time made.

1st – first- I direct that John C. Cox and my wife Mary Cox be the appointed executors ____ my will.

2nd – Secondly – I will to the above named Executers a boundary of land lying in 7th Civil District of Knox County lying in the South East Corner of a tract of land that I Bought of James F. Crippin. Beginning on a rock in the branch in Bells line running parallel with Moses Cox line to Crippins line [interlined: Crippins line Back to the Beginning] then Being five acres more or less

I will that the Executors sell the above named land and pay all my just debts out of the procedes there of my will is that the Residue if any be used in Repairing the Balance of the homestead

I will that the Executors of this will are not required to give Bond and In Witness whereof I do to this my will set my hand and seal this 5 day of December 1884.
