

DECLARATION FOR PENSION OF CHILDREN UNDER SIXTEEN YEARS OF AGE.

State of Tenn County of Union, ss.

On this 7 day of July, A. D. 1882, personally appeared before me I. M. Gentry a Justice of the Peace, the same being a court of record within and for the county and State aforesaid. Elizabeth C. Walker (Gentry) a resident of Union County of Tenn, in the State of Tenn, aged 24 years, who, being duly sworn according to law, makes the following declaration in order to obtain the pension provided by Acts of Congress for children under sixteen years of age: That she is the legal guardian of

legitimate children of Thomas B. Walker who (1) married under the name of Thomas B. Walker at Barnesville, Ky on the 17 day of March A. D. 1862 (2) in Co. C-6 Tenn. Inf. in the war of 1861-5 who died (3) of cholera & from contracted while in the U.S. Service

at Marion, X. Road, Tenn on the 28 day of Oct A. D. 1866 and who bore at the time of his death the rank of Private in (4) the 2nd Tenn. Inf. that he left a widow surviving (5) Elizabeth Walker who died Oct. 27-1875

that the above named she the only surviving legitimate children of said Thomas B. Walker who was under sixteen years of age at the time of his death, of whom (6)

that said children were the issue of said soldier as follows, the date of their birth being as hereinafter stated:
