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as long as I can remember before he enlisted, and I heard him say he had kidney disease, he used to have pain on his back before he enlisted. After his discharge he was troubled in the same way. He had a severe spell with his back and kidneys shortly after his discharge and got so bad he had to be turned over in bed. He never could do more than a half hands work after that. He had no regular Physician before enlistment. Dr. Rogers (deceased) was his family Physician. Dr. Lewis was his physician after discharge. Dr. Lewis died soon after father died. I understand your questions, and answers are correctly recorded in this deposition.
