and that Thomas B Walker who was assergt  
in said Co & Regt was discharged at or  
near Murphreesborough Tenn on account  
of disability who died after he came  
home as an invalid. Said Soldier was  
a stout & strong man when he  
enlisted in the army though the cause  
of a Soldiers Death is unknown to me  
Thomas B Walker was as Faithful a soldier as was  
in my company while in health  
and I have no distrust in this claim
