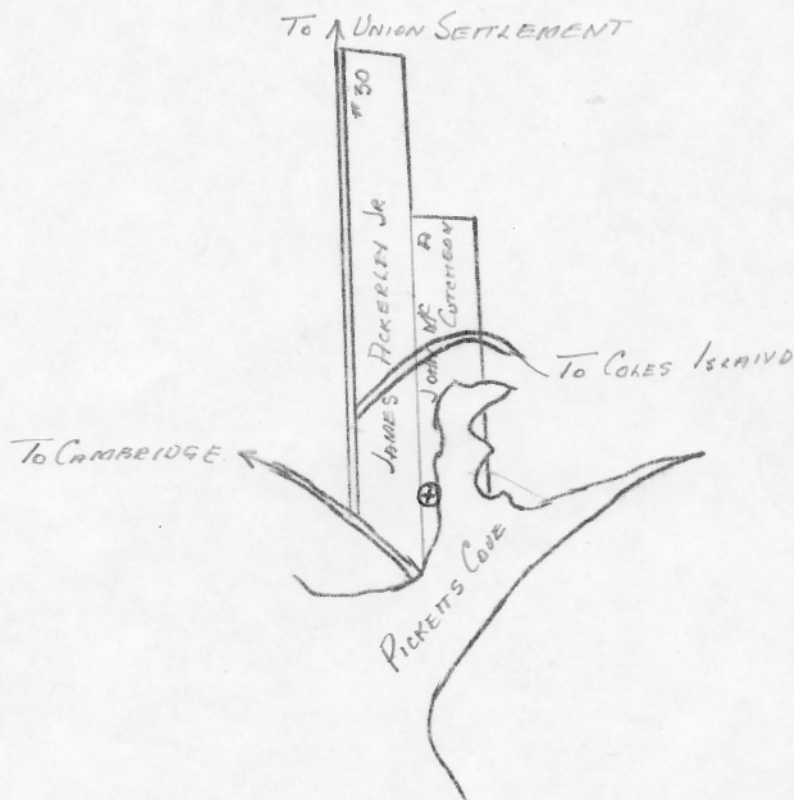


PICKETS COVE GRAVEYARD

This graveyard is situated on land granted to John McCutcheon and known as Lot A in the Collings Survey in the year 1838, X marks its position.

There are only four headstones, but many field stones on edge showing that there were at least 25 graves. The site is completely covered with trees. No one in the community has any knowledge of who is buried there.
