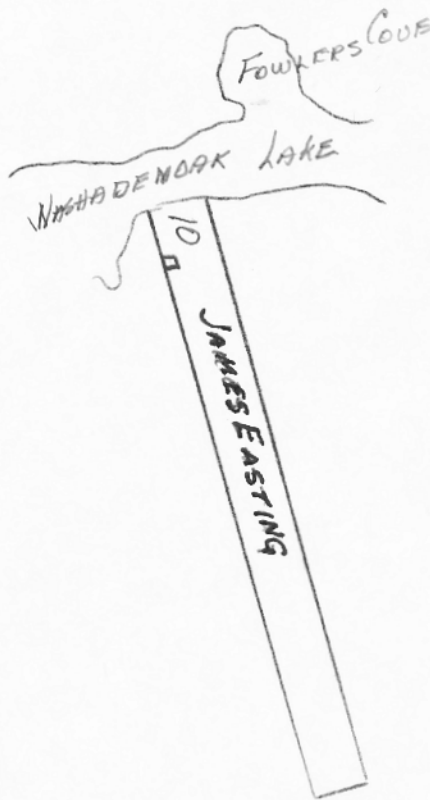

This cemetery is situated on a rise of ground in an open field back of the highway road. There are two maple trees at either end of it. One can see the highway and beyond it the Washademoak Lake. It is on Lot No. 10 originally granted to James Easting^{on}.



There are seven graves that can be easily identified, but no headstones. Mr. Thorne has very little knowledge of who may be buried there -- there has not been a burial for over 50 years.
