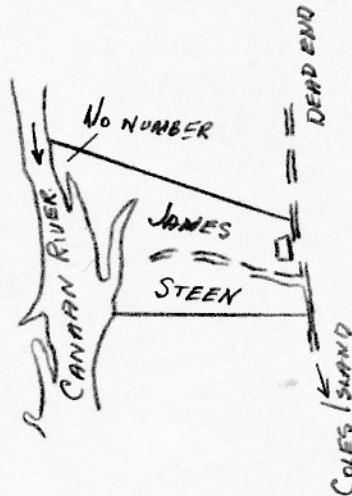


COLES ISLAND ANGLICAN CEMETRY

May 2, 1976



This cemetery is on land originally granted James Steen. It is unusual as there is no number to the Grant. The land is now owned by Rothesay Pulp and Paper.

This cemetery is up the Canaan River by a dead end road from Coles Island.

Mr. George West, who helped me find the graveyard says that when he was a young man (born 1903) the Church was standing and there were a large number of headstones and that it was all fields around the Church.

Now there is only the foundation of the Church left and two headstones. The graveyard has log sized trees covering it. One grave is surrounded by an iron fence and there is a fir tree at least eight inches on the butt and three maples growing on the grave.
