
RIDGE HILL CEMETRY HAMMTOWN



This cemetry is on land originally granted to JAMES EASTING and known as Lot No. 10.

It is difficult to find, as it is in heavy timber-land and there is no road leading to it. It is near the line of what is known as the eastern half of Lot. No. 10. It is about a mile back in the woods from the road between Cody's and The Narrows.

The markers are in among large trees. There was a page-wire fence enclosing it but it has been trampled and just this summer one of the white marble stones has been broken in two by vandals.
