

This Cemetry is on land originally granted to George Cole and known as Lot No. 28. It is now owned by Mr. George Geotling.

The headstone is a double one and made of White Marble, it is broken in three pieces. The site is not fenced and the cattle are feeding around it.

Mr. George West tells me that two children of J.J.West are burried there also. He does not know their names
