'\*' beside the number in Section A column indicates this is an 'OPEN' category, a win does not require a permanent move to Section A.

# Collectable Categories.

There is no maximum number of items in these categories.

Displays to be judged on a group visual basis using variety, condition, quality, showmanship and information. Rarity not significant but desirable.

# IMPORTANT CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

All entries must be displayed on the top of the table provided. Full length drop cloths (to the floor) must be used on displays, failure to do so will lose points. Boxes may be left under the display tables if COMPLETELY hidden from view.

# Swap and Sell:

Minimum 3 feet; Maximum 20 feet (space providing). No exhibitor sub-letting to non-exhibitors.

All exhibits must be ready for judging by 10.00am Saturday otherwise non-exhibitor rates apply. Also substandard displays may result in non-exhibitor rates being charged.

1 entry allows 3 feet at exhibitor rate, remainder at non-exhibitor rate.

2 or more entries – all at exhibitor rate.

Non-exhibitors and non Stall holders are definitely NOT permitted entry into the venue until it is open to the public on Saturday morning.

#### NOTES:

Category 77 MUST be included if collectable categories are provided.

The entry form to provide space for the exhibitor to indicate his choice of either 3 or 4 feet where provided in schedule.

Categories 'Largest & Smallest' and 'One item with a written history' are not to be treated as entries when used as the basis for determining swap and sell space allowances per exhibitor.
