THEREFORE it is considered, that the said *Samuel G Earle* the Plaintiff do recover against the said *Alexander Gilleland* Defendant the sum of *Two Hundred & Eighty Two Dollars & thirty seven* for his Debt aforesaid, and also the sum of *Five Dollars & seventy five* for his costs and charges occasioned by means of prosecuting his suit in this behalf, by the Court here adjudged to the said Plaintiff by his assent, and be the said *Alexander Gilleland* Defendant in mercy, and so forth.
