So Mr. Alexander Gilliland was attached to answer to Fleetwood Rice  
of a plea that he owes unto him the sum of one hundred and nineteen  
dollars and one cent, (together with the lawful interests that may accrue  
thereon) which to him he justly owes, and from him unjustly detains  
&c. And whereupon the said Fleetwood by Perry & Reed his attorneys said  
that, whereas the aforesaid Alexander, on the twenty fifth day of March  
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty three  
at Anderson Court House in the State and District aforesaid, and within  
the Jurisdiction of this Court, by his certain writing obligatory with  
his Seal Sealed and to the Court here shown, the date whereof is the  
day and year aforesaid, has acknowledged himself to be indebted  
to the said Fleetwood in the aforesaid sum of one hundred and nine-  
teen dollars and one cent, to be paid to the said Fleetwood as  
bearer, on the demand thereof, to which payment well and truly  
to be made the aforesaid Alexander bound himself firmly by  
the same bill. Yet the aforesaid Alexander altho' often required,  
the aforesaid sum of money or any part thereof to the said Fleet-  
wood hath not paid, but the same to him to pay hitherto hath  
altogether refused, and still doth refuse to the damage of the  
said Fleetwood one hundred dollars, and therefore he brings his  
suit and so forth.

Gilliland by his assent, and be the said Alexander
