self my heirs and assigns to warrant forever defend the same unto Thomas Gil-
iland his heirs or assigns against myself my heirs Executors Administrators or
assigns or all other persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
thereof whereunto I set my hand and first my seal the 31st of July One thousand eight
hundred and forty four

Three Hundred & Thirty Dollars, being the highest sum that was bid on therefor
Whereas and in consideration of the said sum of Three Hundred and Thir-
ty Dollars by the said Thomas Gilliland paid or secured to be paid I the said
James McDaniel Sheriff as aforesaid have granted bargained and sold and by
these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Thomas Gilliland his
heirs and assigns forever the said tract lot and parcel of land together with
all the appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise incident or appert-
aining and all the estate right title interest and claim whatsoever which the
said David Gilliland deceased of right had or has to the same & to have and
to hold the said tract lot and parcel of land with the appurtenances to the said
Thomas Gilliland his heirs and assigns forever and as fully and absolutely
as I the sheriff as aforesaid might could or ought to grant bargain and sell the
same by virtue of an order from the court of Ordinary of the District of Greenville
