William's parents continued to produce many children over a long period of time, a total of twelve. His youngest sister Rachel was baptised 2nd May 1632 this was the very year that William and Ann Ellis were married. Approximately 50% of William's siblings died in infancy, which was a common infant mortality rate for this period in history. William's mother Frances passed away and was buried 24th June 1634 in All Saints, Kirk Deighton.

Within approximately one year of his mother's death in the year 1635, William Armistead and his wife Ann Ellis departed from England and migrated to Virginia to begin a new life. His own particular family and the remainder of his life are well documented in the history books and archives of the United States of America. William's father Anthony passed away eight years after his wife Frances and was buried 5th October 1642 in All Saints, Kirk Deighton
