OBITUARY
EDWARD E. ALLEN

Edward Elmer Allen, son of Elmer Ellsworth and Lillian Mable Minick Allen was born November 27, 1910 in Auburn, Nebraska. He was one of five children.

He received his education at the Nemaha and Auburn Public Schools and graduated from Lincoln High School in Lincoln, Nebraska. He also attended the University of Nebraska in Lincoln where he was a member of the Farm House Fraternity.

April 17, 1933 he was united in marriage to Rose Lucille Cowell at Nebraska City, Nebraska. To this union two children were born.

After their marriage, Edward and his wife farmed near Bracken, Nebraska. In 1945, Edward and his family moved to Auburn. He was a farmer for 63 years during his active working life. In 1994 Edward and his wife moved to Marshall, Texas.

He was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Auburn. He was a member of the Presbyterian and Methodist Church Choirs in Auburn. He was also a member of the Nemaha Levee District, the Auburn Country Club, the Nemaha Valley Museum and the Sheridan Cemetery Association.

May 26, 1996 Edward was admitted to the Marshall Memorial Hospital in Marshall, Texas. It was there that he passed away on May 27, 1996 having reached the age of 85 years and six

months. He was preceded in death by his parents, one brother, William Lester Allen and one sister, Eda E. Allen.

Those left to mourn his passing are his wife Rose Lucille Allen of Marshall, Texas; two children, Edward E.
