This basketball season provided more thrills and excitement than has been seen at F.H.S. in over a decade. When action was completed in the Delaware Mt. League play, the Mountaineers were nestled in second place with the first winning team since 1956.

The Orangemen produced many memorable moments for their faithful followers. For the first time in many years, we defeated such teams as Treadwell, an arch rival, Andes, as well as non-league triumphs over Stamford, Downsville, and South Kortright, and in our initial encounter with them, we easily defeated Hunter-Tannersville. Scoring 106 points against Treadwell, the Mountaineers set a new school record for most points scored in a single game. In this game Ward Finch established a new individual high for a single game by pouring 38 points through the hoop.

Contributing greatly to our success was a vastly improved defense. Strong rebounding and ball hawking broke up many games and insured victory for the orange and white.





I, Steve Lang, leave to Chuck Maxim, my invaluable ability for getting into trouble, because he doesn't seem to be quite with it.


I, Susan Todd, leave to Wicky (J. Crosby) one bus and one midnight 7-mile walk to make good use of.




