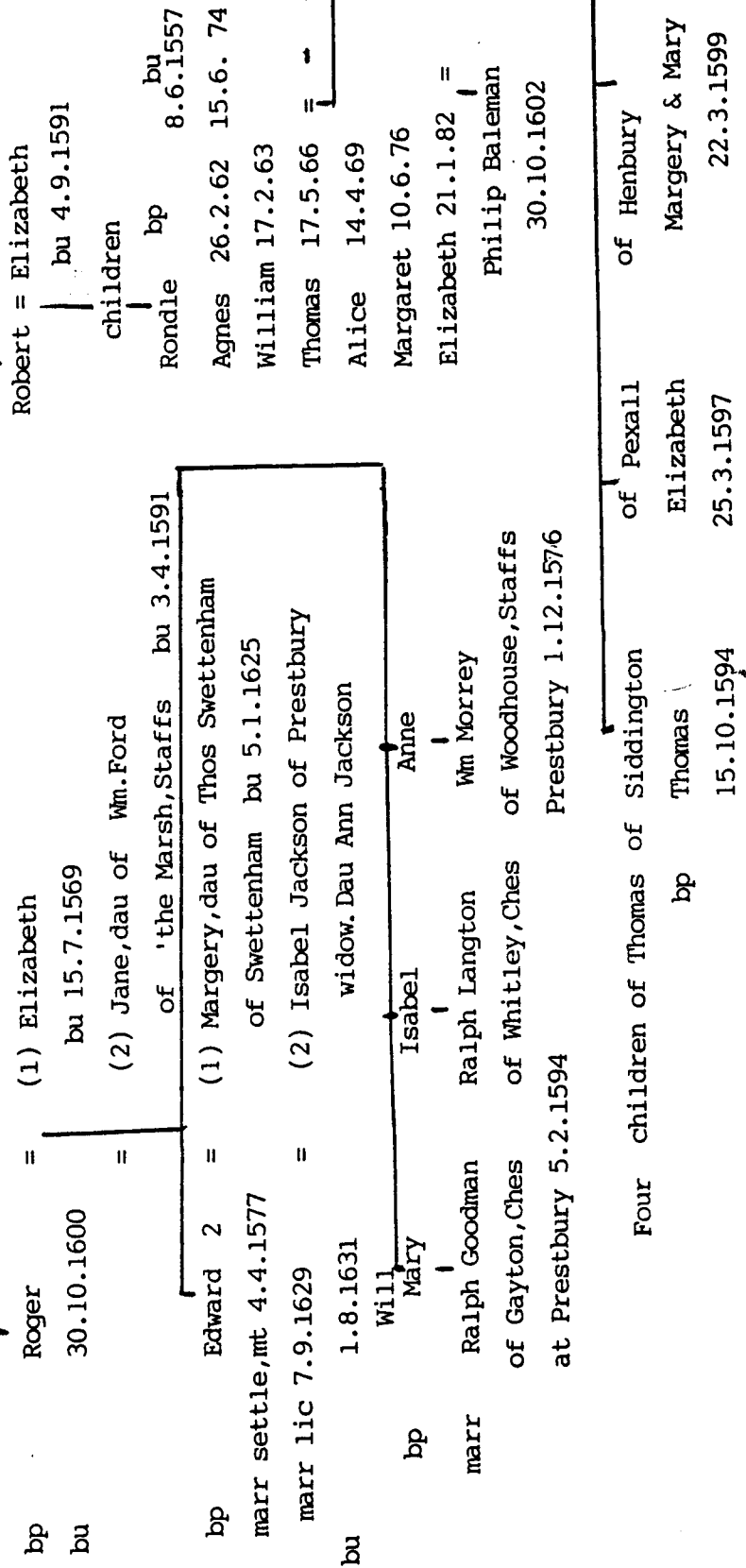

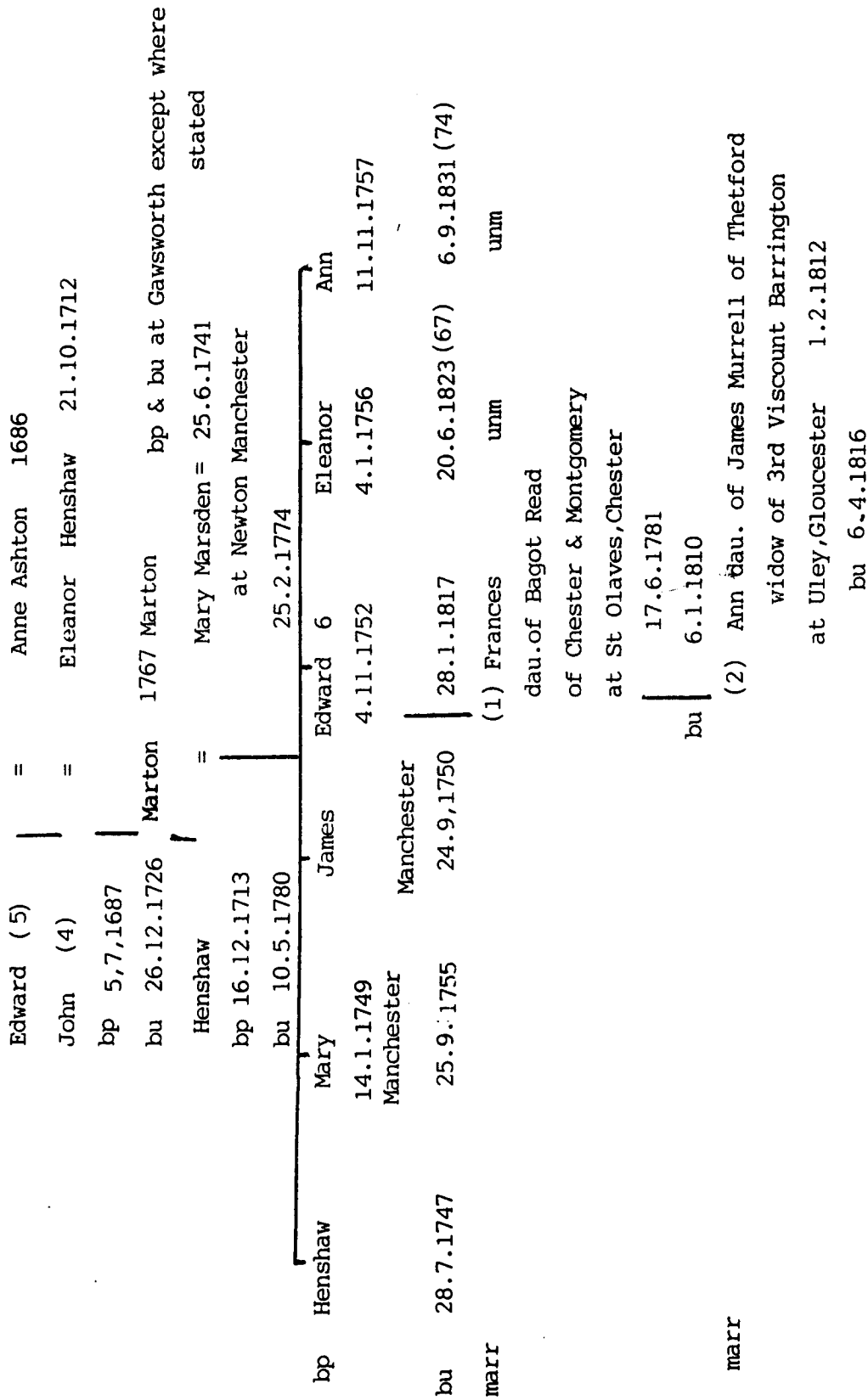

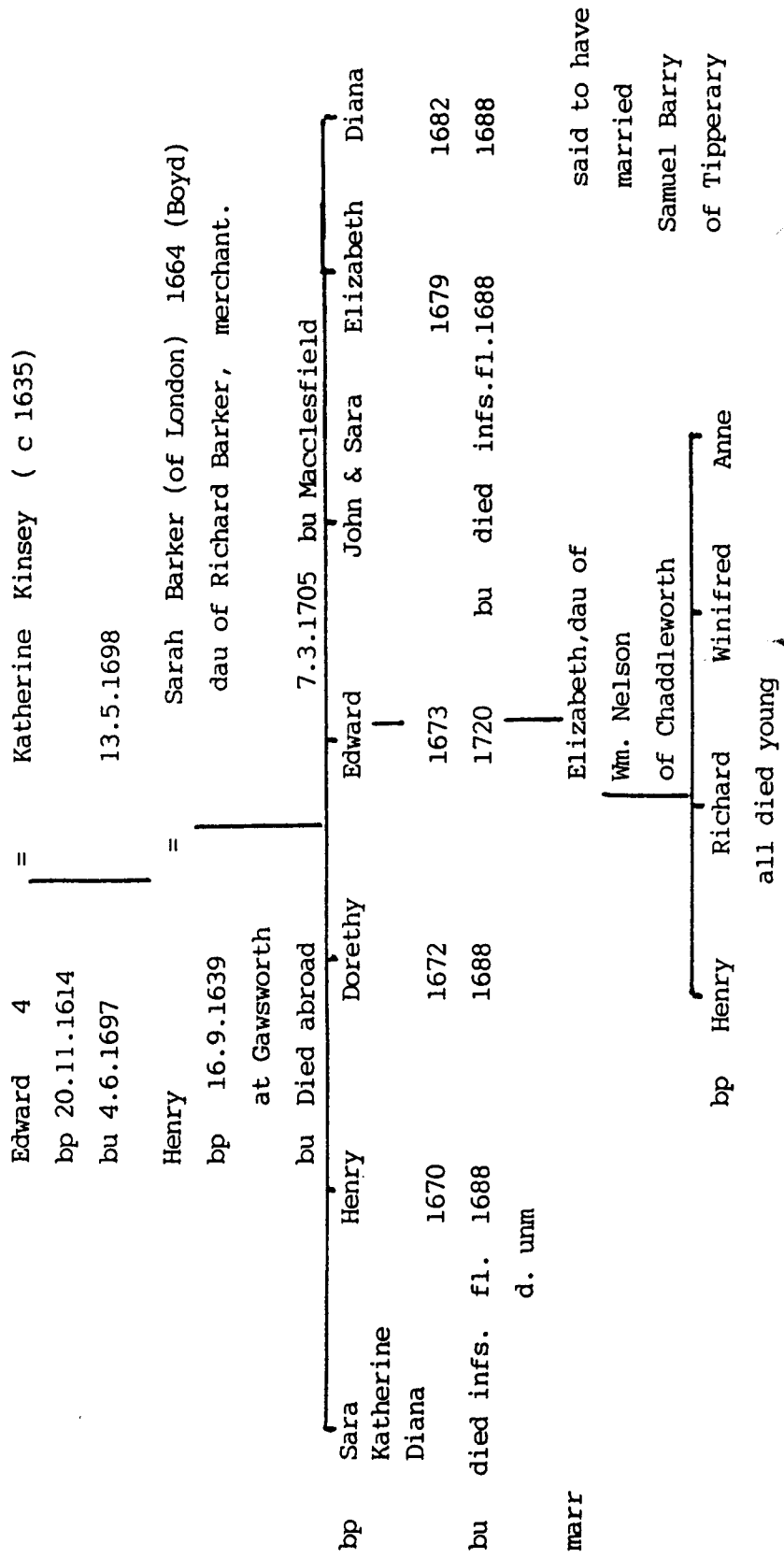

THORNYCROFTS descended from Rev Charles Mytton at Siddington

Edward Thornycroft of Thornycroft who died on 20 Jan 1817 was the last male of the 600 year old line. Under the terms of his Will, after the deaths of his two sisters (who did not marry) the name Thornycroft and the Arms passed to his close friend, the Rev Charles Mytton, rector of Eccleston, Cheshire. At the death of the sisters, Eleanor on 20 Jun 1823 and Ann on 6 Sep 1831, he took the name and arms and this was confirmed by Royal licence on 29 Oct 1831.
