of river.

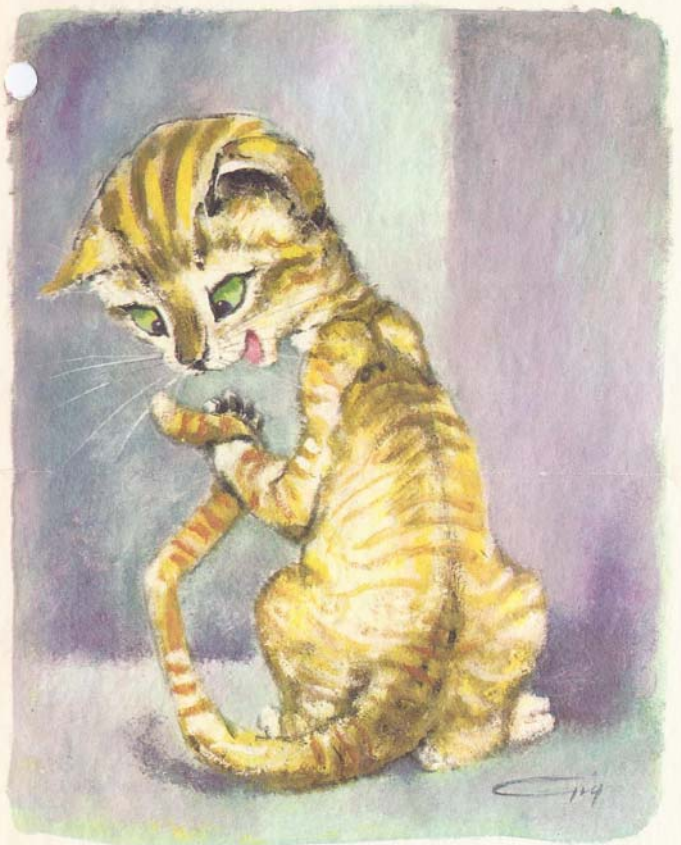

this mailed.

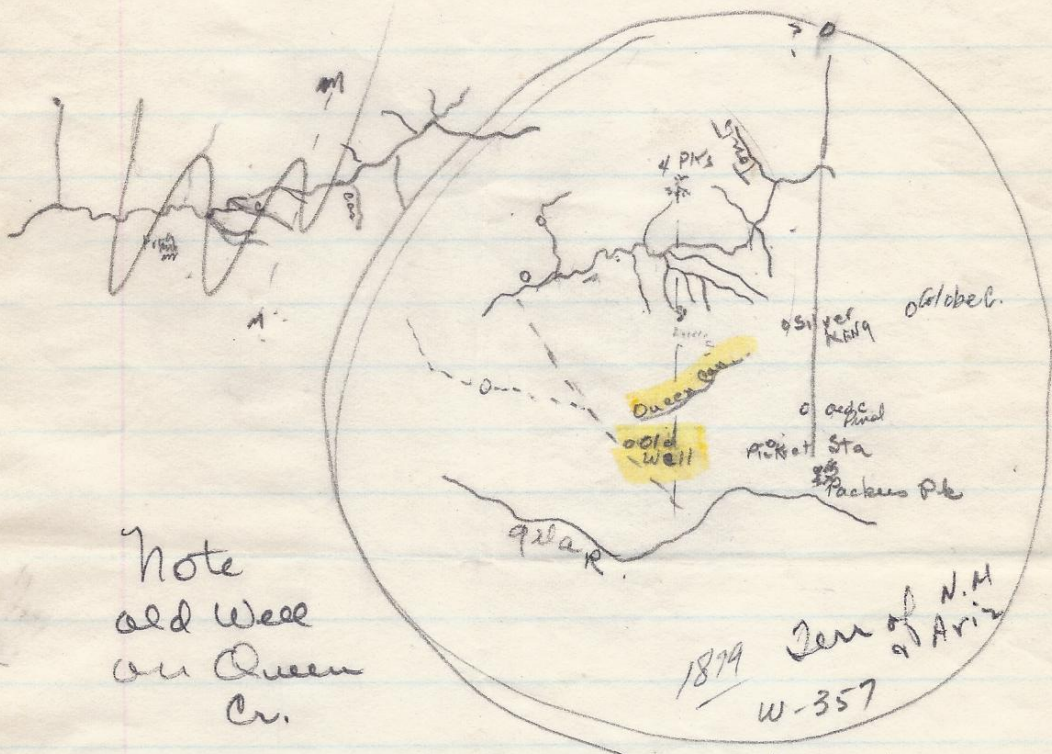
The Walnut Spgs I wrote about

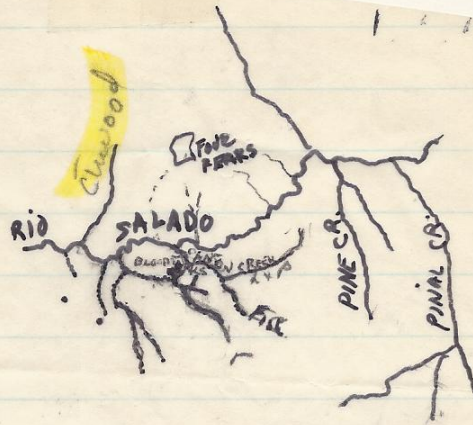

La Barge into Tortilla Crk on Flat

Willow put in about 100 yds south of river - (might depend on last flood + where River channel was on the Flat.

Considering north + south canyons in relation and with 4 peaks above Tortilla Cr - with 3 choices - Merquite - and all Ash Cr - have pot holes, Tortilla also water holes, Peters that hold until late in summer in Tor. + Peters
