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Notes. For a better understanding of the manner in which this page is laid out in the original record, consult the photographic reproduction opposite page 167.

The entry following No. 201 was inserted in 1791 in the space left for the year date 1787. If recorded chronologically, it would be No. 359.

Entries Nos. 0225 and 0226 were inserted by Dominie Romeyn at the right hand side of the page, after the page was completed. In the original record, entry No. 269 is on the right hand side of the page immediately below entry No. 0226. It is assumed that the date Nov. 19, 1788 and the number 269 apply to the names of John Mombrot and Wyntje Mcgrau, although it is not certain. The last entry on the page is also written on the right hand side, at the bottom of the page. The handwriting is not that of Dominie Romeyn, but appears to be the same as that of the date "Nov. 19 '88", just above it.

Entry No. 195. Cf. baptism entries 1114 and 1495.

Entry No. 198. Wiaht Yale with Hoyer's daughter. Cf. baptism entries 1175 and 1644.

Entry No. 203. The name of the husband is doubtful. Josiah Swart was a resident of the town of Mohawk (Florida and Charleston); cf. Census of 1790, page 110.

Entry No. 204. The name of the husband may be "van Everen".

Entry No. 211. Cf. baptism entry 1176.

Entry No. 224. The items marked # are not destroyed, but are illegible; the names have been supplied by guesswork and may be disregarded and the photographic copy consulted.

Entry No. 253. This number follows in proper chronological order, after No. 257, on page 170.

Note. For a long time in Dominie Van Horne's records, as far as the middle initials of names are concerned, it is impossible to distinguish between the letters I, J and T. The custom of the son adopting his father's first name for his middle name is a survival from the Dutch patronymics. That is to say, if the father's name was John or Jacob, the middle initial of the son would be J. Apparently, for a time, Dominie Van Horne wrote the letters I, J and T exactly the same. Consequently, the transcription of these letters when they appear as middle initials, is a matter of good judgement or good luck, on the part of the copyist. The only sure way to be absolutely correct in every case, is to have positive information as to the father's first name. In making this transcript up to this point, my plan has been to transcribe the middle initial as "J" in almost every case. The reason being, because John and Jacob are more common names than Isaac, Thomas or Timothy. Up to this point, I believe that this plan has been well adapted to this record.

At about this point in the record, Dominie Van Horne seems to have discovered the art of writing the middle initial "J". It now appears in the [This note continued on next page.]

names Peter J. Quackenboss and John J. Livingston. This change of style by the Dominie has made it necessary to modify the plan adopted. Hereafter, the letters I, J and T will be transcribed as I, unless there is some special reason for acting otherwise. When Dominie Van Horne wrote "J" it will be transcribed "J". The middle initials I and J are constantly confused in most church records. For some unknown reason many sons having fathers named John or Jacob, turn up in later years with the middle initial "I". Throughout Dominie Van Horne's records, whenever the middle initials I, J or T appear, genealogists need feel no hesitancy about adopting the letter best suited to the name of the father, irrespective of the manner in which the entry has been transcribed.
