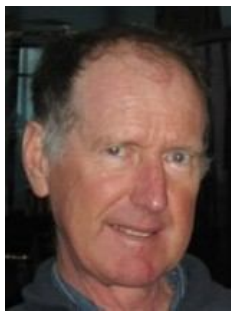


## Heberle, Gregory William

Department name changed to Dept of Conservation and Land Management (CALM) in 1985. With CALM at Bunbury 1987-90 (departmental forest planner), Perth 1990-2001 (economics, forest resource planner, forest auditor). Fished with family professional fishing business at Doubtful Is Bay in March each year (annual leave) 1965-66, 1969-2002. Lived in Bunbury 1987-90; Nollamara 1990-99; Craigie 1999-2006, with partner Wendy Poynton, 1999-2004. Lived in South Yunderup 2006 -, in house on canal. Retired from CALM 28.6.2001. Defacto marriage 1982-92, to Cheryl Yvette Head, who changed name to Heberle. Children: Tania, Stacey, Brian.
