Dies in accident at age 82, former MS secretary, Aldayr Heberle

He was killed in a car accident on Monday morning, near the city of Gravataí / RS, the former Secretary of State for Tourism, Industry and Commerce of Mato Grosso do Sul, Aldayr Heberle, 82. The information was confirmed by the PRF (Federal Highway Police) of Gravataí. According to record of the cameras of the highway concessionaire.

The vehicle driven by Aldayr Heberle, a Ford Ka, crashed into a truck at 9:47 am (14.8.2017), and the left lane of the highway towards Porto Alegre-coast had to be partially blocked. He was alone in the vehicle. According to the PRF, the driver of the truck, which did not have the name revealed, made a return used only for emergency vehicles and the former secretary could not avoid the crash. According to the Federal Highway Police, he died at the scene.

Gaucho from the city of Ijuí, Aldayr Heberle was living in Buenos Aires when he was invited by Pedro Pedrossian to become Secretary of State for Tourism, Industry and Commerce in 1991. When Pedrossian's warrant was over, he decided to settle in Campo Grande, where he lived for 22 years and four years ago he returned to Rio Grande do Sul.

Always connected to the sector of industry and commerce, Aldayr Heberle was considered forerunner of the export of soya in bulk from Brazil to Europe. In 1962, instead of bagged soybeans, he exported a cargo of five thousand tons packaged directly in the basements of a ship, a story he reported in the book "Soy in Brazil and in the World - Memories, Lectures, Comments and Lived Stories". Expogrande 2014.

In 2004, already in the management of the former governor Zeca of the PT, Aldayr Heberle returned to be part of the State Government, in the position of coordinator of the Advisory of Planning of Studies and Projects of Environment and Water Resources. Aldayr Heberle was the brother of Erli Heberle, who was director of the Regional Hospital, and is currently a member of Sicredi's Board of Directors in Ponta Porã.
