Mrs. Heberle, Verona, Dies

VERONA — Mrs. June E. Heberle, 79, widow of Arthur A. Heberle, died in the Carter Nursing Home, Oneida, Sunday, where she had been a patient since last April. Mrs. Heberle had been ill since last October.

She was born in Verona Mills, Sept. 13, 1878, the daughter of George P. and Margaretta Warner Wheadrick. She received her education in the Verona school, and on Jan. 23, 1907, in Geneva, was married to Mr. Heberle.

After their marriage, the couple lived in Churchville for a short time, later moving into Rome where Mr. Heberle was employed as a motorman on the Street Railways. In 1921, they moved to a farm at The Rocks, Verona, and Mrs. Heberle had since resided there. Mr. Heberle died March 18, 1952.

Mrs. Heberle leaves two sons, Warner C., who resided at home with his mother, and Milton A. Heberle, Verona village; a grandson, Christian G. Heberle, Verona. Mrs. Heberle was the last of a family of seven children. Other survivors include two nieces, Miss Laura J. Wheadrick, Lockport, and Helen Whalen, Columbus, Ohio.

Mrs. Heberle was a member of St. Peter's Lutheran Church of Verona, and the Willing Workers Society of that church; she also was a member of Vesta Chapter, OES., New London, and the Verona WCTU.

Funeral services will be held at the Waldo Wiggins Prince Home for Funerals, Rome, on Wednesday at 2 p.m. with the Rev. George E. Kenyon Jr., pastor of St. Peter's Lutheran Church officiating. Burial will be in St. Peter's Lutheran Cemetery.

Members of Vesta Chapter, OES., will meet at the funeral home at 8 p.m. Tuesday to pay their respects.
