HEBERLE, MARGARET E., age 98, passed away on Thursday, July 26, 2012 at The Hospice of Dayton. She persuaded the company to let her take its courses in radio, electronics, computers, and mathematics, took the books home and studied at night on her own. No woman had ever taken these courses, and she passed them all, eventually teaching the courses and leading an engineering group before being offered a job at Bell Labs in 1973 where she supervised a program adapting engineering to computer operating systems at the advent of computers and the transistor. She eventually earned two associate degrees, one in science and one in mathematics before retiring in 1977. Margaret was a member of the Ohio Bell Choir, St. Marys Church Choir, the Church of the Incarnation Choir and the Cameo Chorale, Following her retirement, she volunteered as a bookkeeper at the Nearly New Shop of the Little Exchange for 25 years and was a tax counselor for the elderly at Bethany Village until just a couple of years before her death.
