John Deemer, aged sixty nine years, (6)
has not for years before the war
been able to support the applicant by
reason of disease - lame leg - which
are constantly suppurating

 5. "Wholly," or "in part."
 6. If husband is dead so state, giving date of death; also whether applicant has remarried. If still living, his inability to support applicant should be accounted for.
 7. If either she or the soldier has previously applied, so state, giving number of claim.
