Respectfully returned to the Commissioner of Pensions.

John Seemer, a Pvt of Company G,
9th Regiment Pa Cavalry Volunteers, was enrolled on the
6th day of April, 1863, at Harrisburg, Pa (3 yrs),
and is reported: on muster rolls of Co from enrollment
to Aug 31, 1863 present for duty. Sept + Oct 1863,
absent, left at hosp'l Bridgeport, Ala Oct 26, 1863.
Nov + Dec 1863 same report. Jan + Feb 1864, at Nash-
ville, in hosp'l. Mch + April 1864 absent on courier
duty at Cleveland, Tenn, since April 14, 1864.
So reported on roll for May + June 1864. July + Aug
1864 absent, detailed as cattle guard from Nashville
to Atlanta. Sept + Oct 1864 absent without remark.
Nov + Dec 1864, absent, taken prisoner in Oct
1864 (Co was in action Oct 12, 1864, at Lafayette,
Ga) So reported on subsequent rolls to April 30,
1865. May + June 1865 died of wounds received
Mch - 1865
